

HAMPSHIRE, ss.

To the Sheriff of the said County of Hampshire, or either of his deputies, or the Constables of the Town of Belchertown within the said County, or to any or either of them, GREETING.

IN the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are required to attach the Goods or Estate of *Daniel Chapman of Belchertown* aforesaid Gentleman

to the value of *twenty five* Dollars, and for want thereof, to take the body of the said *Daniel* (if he may be found in your Precinct) and him safely keep, so that he may be had before me, *Justice* *Forward* *Esq.* one of the Justices of the Peace for the County aforesaid, at my dwelling-house in Belchertown, in said county, on Saturday the *sixteenth* day of *August* next at one of the clock, in the afternoon, then and there to answer to *Henry Miller & Emory Sanford both*

of Belchertown partners in trade under the firm of Miller & Sanford

In a plea of trespass on the case, for that the said *Daniel* at said *Belchertown* on the *day of* *August* by his promissory note of hand of that date, for value received, promised the plaintiff to pay him or order *five* dollars and *no* cents.

Also for that the said *Daniel* at said *Belchertown* on the *day of* the purchase of this writ, was justly indebted to the plaintiff in the sum of *fifteen* dollars and *no* cents for *divers goods wares & merchandises* by the plaintiffs to the defendant and at his especial instance and request, and being so indebted, in consideration thereof, the said *Daniel* did then and there assume on himself and faithfully promise the plaintiff to pay him the same sum on demand.

Yet the said *Daniel* though often thereto requested hath not performed his said promise, but neglects it. To the damage of the said *Henry* (as he saith) the sum of Twenty Dollars, as shall then and there appear, with other due damages. Hereof fail not, and make due return of this Writ, and of your doings therein, unto myself, on or before the said *sixteenth* day of *August* next Dated at *Belchertown*, aforesaid, the *twentieth* day of *April* in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and *seventy*
