KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That the Peninsular Mausoleum Company, a corporation, by R. E. Corbin, its Treasurer, being duly authorized, in consideration of Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars to it paid by G. F. Westphall, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby bargain and sell and convey to G. F. Westphall his heirs and assigns forever, the following crypts and burial places located and situated in the Mausoleum in the Township of Chesaning, in the County of Saginaw, in the State of Michigan, on land described as lying East of the vault on the North side of the Highway of the new cemetery, Section 28, said crypts being known and described as Crypts No. 169-199 upon the recorded plat of said Mausoleum now on file therein, together with the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging;

To have and to hold to the said G. F. Westphall his heirs and assigns forever, on this express condition, that if sold to any negro or person of negro descent, this deed to be void. And this deed is made subject to all by-laws of the owners of Crypts and rules of any Board of Health.
