We are about 125 miles from Niagara Falls, near Hornell - southeast from Buffalo.


We are going to Albania to take charge of a school and a 500 acre school farm. The location borders on the Adriatic Sea, just a few miles from Durazzo, the principal seaport of this little country. Albania is just north of Greece. It is about the size of New Hampshire and Vermont together. We go with a three year contract, so that if our health is all right there we won't be in the U. S. A. for a little over three years.

They are anxious for us to get there. They would like to have us leave right away, but I guess I won't be able to get away until the end of the school year.

We are rather busy getting ready to go. Byron is looking forward to the big ride across the ocean. We're not expecting to be sea-sick. We wish we could spend a couple of weeks in Michigan before going, but there is no chance of doing this.

Will try to write again some time. Haven't much time now.
