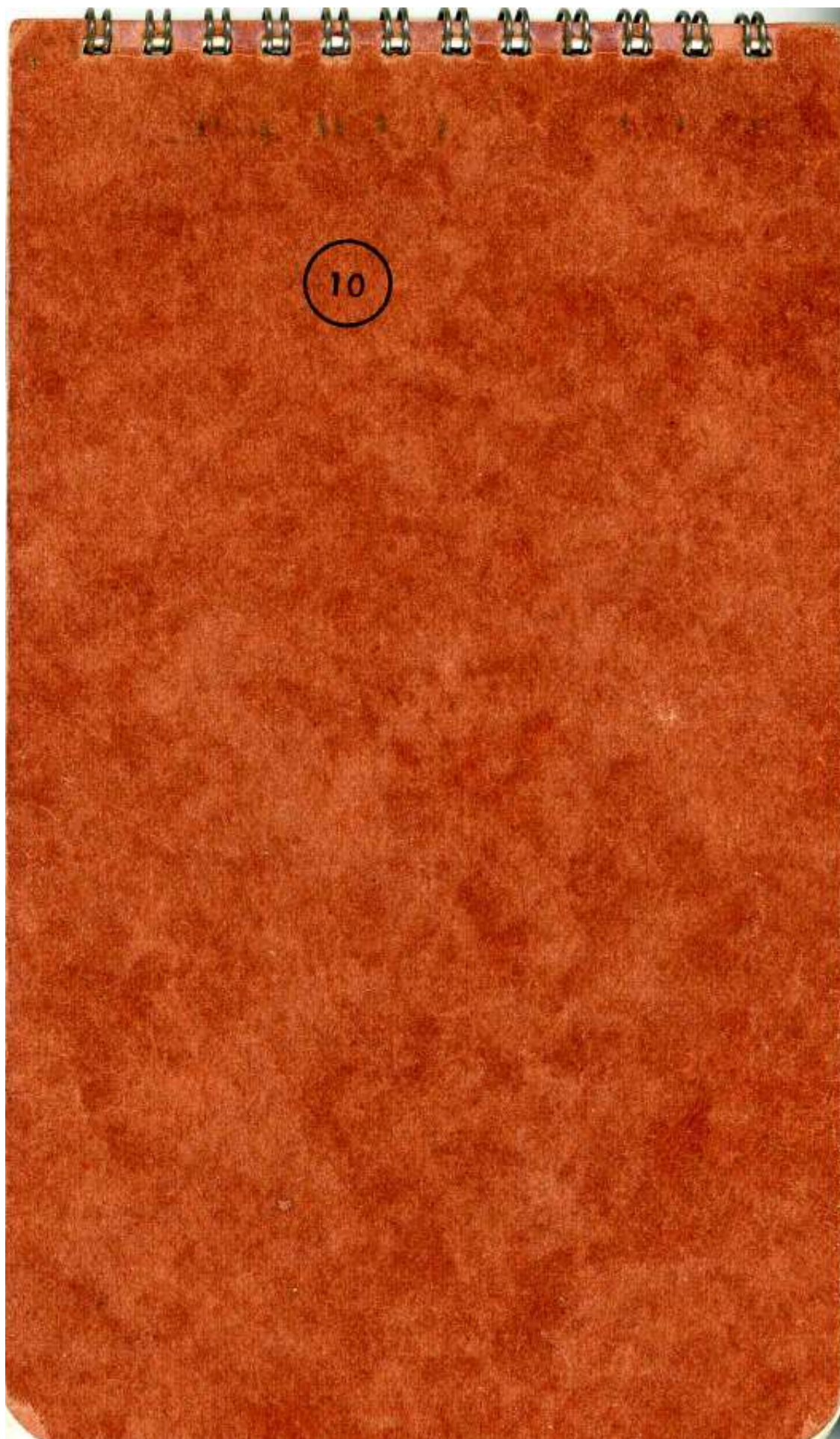

morning. Cloudy. Hung sheets
on line and saw the
neighbors beautiful flowering
peach or plum tree pretty red
all in blossom.

called Mrs. Hall They live
at

David J. Hall. 2802 E Elm.

His mother is with Betty
at Tucums her husband
died and she remarried.

The Halls have 6 children

the oldest boy 24 girl 22

married girl 20 at university

and youngest 10 years old.

They are flying out Feb. 21

to see his mother who

is blind.

Received letter from Dorothy

was surprised but glad.

Temperature 72° high 69°

this evening

Hills took us to Mission

in the sun and to

Savino Canyon. The Canyon

is about 15 miles from

Hills.

We saw a car from
Michigan and found they
were from Ypsilanti and
their name was John
Brown.

We drove through U. of
Arizona on way home.
Feb 10. Sun. It rained
during the night. Started
raining again while we
were at Church and it
just poured and thunder
and lightning. It rained
all afternoon so just
stayed home and rested
and wrote letters.

Temperature 62° to 45° at night.

Feb 11

Rained most of the day.
We just knitted and talked
most of the time.

Temperature 52° and low

Feb. 12,

Temperature 42° this morning,
Went down town shopping.
Went ^{to} Bakery. You get a
number and wait your turn.
Houses are one story also most
Buildings are one story. Roofs
stone or tile.

Montgomery Ward store Stone
front, very pretty.

Railroads one of the major
places to work.

Temperature 42° low 55° at
nine o'clock P.M. 41°

Visited the Meeke next
door and Mrs. Ward in
evening. George stayed with
the wards while Marjorie
was in Hospital.

Feb. 13,

Wrote to all my ladies.
 35° this morning. Frost on

windshield. Went over to
George's this afternoon.

It was 50° during the
day. We went to prayer
meeting last night.

Saw a man mowing grass
in front of a Dairy Queen
building. It was winter
rye.

Received letter from Charles
and Barbara.

Feb. 14. Temperature 36°
this morning.

Margorie, Laura and I left at
9:30 to museum about
18 miles from her place.

It's one of the largest museums.
We drove in to the trailer
estate. No children can
live there. They have
swimming pool picnic grounds
golf and so on.

We went pass Old Tucson
where they made western
movies. part of Oklahoma
was made there.

We spend 3 hours in
the museum. Animals
Birds, fish snakes, cactuses

We went in a tunnel
and the only light you
pushed a railing and it
would light up the places
where the animals were.

After leaving the museum
we drove to picnic ground
but it was to cold to
eat at tables so sat in
car and had our lunch.

On way home we stopped
at Old Mission built
1797. Papago Indians
live around there.

They build their houses of

Clay and straw formed in to
brick. [] Dobie Brick.

She drove out of town
to show me cotton fields
but did not locate any.

We went pass Hughes
Air craft factory now made
missiles.

It is for 65 yrs of age.
Temperature 60°

Feb 16. Temperatures 37°
It varied around the town
28° to 40° people calling in,
to radio.

Maryon went down to
church and Louisa made
date cookies and I swept
the house.

In afternoon Louisa wanted
to go see some food

exhibits at church. The
read about in paper. But
we did not find anyone
when we got there. Stopped
at New Baptist church on
way which was very
interesting. Choir in back.
Then drove to The Garden

auditorium. We arrived
a few minutes after 7:00
and it was about $\frac{1}{2}$ full
thom by 7:30 it was full
and they set chairs up on
stage about and stage below
and people were standing
and they turned over 100
away. The auditorium holds
2500 and they figured
that around 3200 were
there. We came home and
watched T.V. news and
went to bed tired.

Feb. 18, Temperature low 39°
and high 62°

Margie went up to church
to clean and Louise and I
washed a couple loads. In
afternoon went to a couple
of shopping centers.

Louisa got a new dress
and I got the rest of my
yarn.

Margorie took us to a
store all my itself. called
SAVE CO it had every-
thing in it from drugs
prescriptions, groceries, drygoods
furniture and anything you
could think of also gas
station and auto accessories.
We saw them packaging
cheese. cut wrap and stamps.
We stopped at a friend
of Margorie's Gen Leist
who Margorie met at the
city of Hope.

Feb 19 Temperature 40° low
70° high. The first we could
go without wrap in afternoon.
We went to church to
Ladies Circle at 11:30 had
sock lunch. Had meeting and

then went down town
to get projector to see
Louise's and Marjorie's moves.
Got some groceries at store
where they had milk in
gallon bottles, gallon can of
olives, mustard, pickles and
lots of gallons of fruit.
Drove through Cemetery.
They had stones of the
Bible. Twenty third psalm.
statues of Christ.

She drove through a
housing division. People
buy there homes. \$200. down
65. per month. Gravel in
front lawns. Some had grass
in back and some had green
gravel. The back was
concrete blocks for fence
and a car port

came home and found a package from Frank and it had a projector in it. They were depressed as they paid 1.75 to rent one. George and Rita came for supper. After we got dishes done Mrs. Langdon, Helen Lynch, Nancy and Jack Nancy's boy friend came over to look at pictures.

Had a real nice time George had quite a time to get projector to work. Went to bed about 10:30 Very tired.

Feb. 20 Temperature low 42° high 74° Detroit 23° snow. They have school signs & School Xing.

We did up morning work Louise washed her hair and I rinsed.

We knitted and I finished
head scarf.

In afternoon Margorie and I
took projector back and
went to bakery Holsum to
get day old bread it was
15¢ a loaf I got two
loaves for our lunch.
Come home helped get our
supper ready for The
Michigan Club at 6:30
at Shrine. Margorie made
Brown bobbis and took
Bibbles and tuna fish
casserole. There were around
150 people at Club. A
couple from Lansing lived
in back of Resurrection
and Leslie Wilcox cousin
her name was Ted. Then
she married Watson and
now her name is Hyatt.

She knows Mrs. Hadley.
After our supper each one
had to tell their name
and where they are from.
A lady sat across table
from me from Warren
Mich. They then divided
us in two groups and
we went through
Palms Funeral Home.
They had cashed \$3,320.00.
We then came home listened
to the news and weather
and then got into bed.

Feb 21 Got up around 7:15
We planned to watch Radio
on T.V. Marguerite said that
her neighbors were going
and I said I wish I
could go along and she
said she would go over
and see if I could. They
were going to have their

station wagon full but said
that her niece was going
and I could go with them.
We left at 8:15 AM and
got over on 5th ave and
94th street around 8:30 and
we stood up until after
the parade. It started at
10:00 and lasted until 12:10
It took us about 1 hr. to
get home.

They estimated 150 000
people at parade.

I got one side of my face
sun burned.

Came home had lunch
and rested for a while
and then washed my hair.
Temperature 42° low 73° high.
Feb. 22 Banks closed. We
forgot about it and planned

to get checks cashed today.

We went to see Mrs Miller last night.

She took care of Mayrie ten years ago. Mayrie had not been out where she was staying and it was quite a distance out in the mountains. We got lost and drove up and down dips, it was real pretty at this place looking at the city at night. Mrs Hunter was the people's place where we went.

She has nephew in Lansing who works at Sed factory. Her brother lived 3 miles from Chebasson.

Feb 22. Temperature about the same as yesterday.

Mayrie said it being Washington Birthday the bombas would be

closed. We planned to get
check cashed so see game
us \$20.00 and wrote check
for her groceries. We all
got groceries at Safeway Store.
We went over to say good-
by to Helen and Mrs.

Maeber came over to say
goodby to us.

After supper Margorie did the
dishes and we went to depot
to pick up our reserve
seats. George and Rita came
home in evening. We
went to bed at 10:10 and
Feb 27 got up at 12:15 AM. The
train was due at 2:00
AM but it was late
so we left Margorie at
1:45 AM. and got to station
at 2:00 checked our bags.

and the train pulled in at 2:30
We got on train and Mary Jane
and I left. It was 3:00
before we left Tucson.

I did not sleep but watched
the train going through
the mountain. Saw the
front of train 2 times.

When it began to get light
I counted 17 trucks driving
quite close to tracks.

Stopped at Al Pass 8:40

lefted 9:20 AM. Large
railroad center we rode
through large sand dunes,
and a large settlement of
Mexican houses.

North of Alamoondo across
from white sands a mountain
in the distance was
all covered with snow.
We drove for miles and
could see it.

we could see it for 1 hr.
Snow on level right next
to tracks. Between Carrizozo
and Santa Rosa.

5:35 P.M. just gone in to
Texas.

We get off at Tucuman
a few minutes. Louis
bought a paper of Albuquerque
journal. It seemed quite
nice but there was some
snow and mud.

Feb 24 Got a few hours sleep.
was awake from 1:00 AM to
3:00 AM Saw the big
City of Kansas City Missouri
with all its lights. Snow
all over ground at Kansas City
and from there on.

Crossed over Mississippi River
8:00 AM frozen.

We stopped for $\frac{1}{2}$ hr or more
in Rock Island and they
had to put on another coach.
Arrived Chicago 12:30 PM Sunday.
Leaving Chicago we saw the
Skyway Toll Bridge.

Lever Bros. make soap.

Lake Michigan part frozen.

Michigan City 3:05 PM.

More snow after leaving
Mich City.

Miles changed watches 4:40

Dinner did not stop.

Large grape arbors before we
get Kalamazoo.

Florida Trip.

Left Lansing 11:45 on Tues.
Feb 4 1966

Got to Anderson Indiana,
around 7:00 PM. Stayed
all night at oil station
very nice place quite and
real clean.

Feb 5

Stayed over night at park
near Bowling Green. It rained
all night and most of Thurs.
We were afraid we would
get stuck getting out of park.
I drove around 50 miles.
Feb 6 Cost just 10¢ per person.
mailed cards to all the
children.

We are staying at Shell gas
station 73 miles south of
Tennessee line and 32 north
of Birmingham.

The speedometer read 10,000
near Columbia Tenn.
Feb 7

We drove through real
bad fog.

Ate out lunch and rested
at oil station near
Prattville

Took our lawn chair out
and ate our lunch in them.
Temperature was 75°

Arrived at Jones in Auburn
Alabama at 4:30

Stayed with Jones until
Sun. Feb 9

Stayed all night at State
Park near Lake City.
Feb 10

Arrived at Zepher around
4:30 got set up around

6:00.

The Smiths helped us find

a park.

The Hallbauer's came over and stayed until 7:30 We went out to see them and have dinner on Feb 11

Took us most of the day getting our mail figured out buying a used mail box, Feb 12

Went out to see Raymond Knapp Mrs. Knapp's brother but did not find them home Saw a large strawberry field next door.

Bought $\frac{1}{2}$ bu. oranges ^{\$1.00}; Went out to Hallbauer to paint mail box.

Went through egg packing plant in Zephyr Feb 13

We went to Busch gardens

around 28 miles from here
near Tampa.

Got there around 10:30 and
got home around 4:30

It was very nice.

Saw University of South
Florida. It was cement and
white color.

Feb 14

Got our mail box up. Saw
a large turkey farm near
Holtzhaus's.

Went to see Mrs. Oliver's
brother but they were
not home. Went to bed
around 8:00 Did not
have any heat the first
night since we left home

Feb 15

Temperature 62 this morning
at Tampa. Wind blew all

night, and is still windy
this morning. Wanted to
wash but I guess I will
wait until Mon.

They are having a hobby and
babe sale here today.

It rained most of the fore-
noon. We bought a shell
at the hobby show.

Afternoon rested and took
a shower. Got our T.V. in
and set up.

Went to Thriftway Grocery
store and got a few
groceries. They had 7 check
out places and they were
real busy. Got first mail 16 pieces
Feb 16 Sun.

We went to Methodist
Church at 2.45 p.m. at 8.30.

Large attendance. Come home
did breakfast dishes put up

lunch while Charles
took a nap.
Not ready to go to Safety
Harbor to see John Lucie
we ate lunch. Before getting
there, they wanted us to
stay all night,
we went to see The
Kapok tree inn, in
Clearwater.

Feb 17

Left Lucie's around 9:30
Hunted up the Scholz
had a hard time finding
them. Stayed for dinner
and after dinner went with
Mrs. Scholz over to Hall
for a meeting. Left Scholz's
around 3:30 got home
around 5:00. 58 miles
for Scholz's home.

took a nap and had supper
and then wrote cards &
letters.

Feb 18 Has been real cool
today. Washed and got my
clothes dried.

We went to see a big
poultry place 23,000 Birds,
also drove by several
others. One 60,000 layers.

Man said they make around
1.00 per Bird. getting 70%

Came home had lunch and

groceries. And went to
the new Ekus Drug store
that just opened.

Daddy and I practiced shuffle
board together. It was nice
out in the sun.

Mar 15

Cloudy today. Went over to
see 2 poultry farms. One raises
pullets and the other laying
hens.

Asked Mr. & Mrs. Haber over
for the evening. They are from
Iowa. She was raised in
Montana. Taught rural school.
Rode horseback to and from
school. Boarded near school

in the winter. They stayed
until 10:30. I served coffee
and cookies.

Mar 16

Started raining early in
the morning and rained
all day and all night.
Had to stay inside all
day. It was a long day
to be in a trailer.

Daddy went over to the
Habeas and got a book of
Montana to read.

Mar 17

Was still raining off
and on today.

Went out to Hallbavens
for a couple of hours.
Ordered some grapefruit
to take home and got
some groceries.

Rained 4 in. yesterday.
Mar 18.

Went to Lakeland to Tiger
Ball Game. Tigers lost 6-2.
It rained a couple times
once before game started
and again around fourth
inning.

Got home around 5:00 o'clock.
Round Trip 51 miles.
Stopped and picked up
1 lb of grapefruit we had
2 orchards.

Mar 19

Daddy got car oiled and
greased. I wrote to all the
children had lunch, nap and
Daddy played schuffle board.
Had supper. Went to
American Legion 50th Birthday
Anniversary. About 75 people
there. Had Birthday cake.

Mar 20 Wasted a beautiful
day one of the first,
we had a cook out at
Trailer Court,
Stopped at Robert Kopp's a
little while to see about
picking oranges Sat,
Mar 21

Another nice day. Left here
around 8:30 went to
Tampa. Called the Bidwells
but no answer drove over
to Tampa Bay, Sat on the
shore and ate our lunch
around 11 hours, Then drove
to Safety Harbor to see
The Lucius again. Got
home around 3:30 I drove
around 20 miles home.

Mar 22.

We picked oranges at Robert

Koffe. Bought Groceries and
got 2 bu. of grapefruit.
Daddy played shuffle
and won I game. Mrs Mrs
Ray Knapp came while he
was playing. They didn't
stay long. In evening we
went over to see Mr and
Mrs. Bacon. She is in
wheel chair. was injured
about 27 years ago. They
have been married 56 years.
They live in New York.
It was another beautiful
day. A little ^{too} warm during
the middle of the day
March 23

Went to the Lutheran Church
The Wallbaums took us
out for dinner at Restaurant
in 2ephyrills. \$1.15 per
person. All the salads you

eat. I had ham and Boddely
had roast beef.
Got home about 2:00 and
had a nap. The wind was
quite strong but it was
a nice warm day.

Mar 24

It rained most all day. Got
Trailer hooked on and all
ready to start out Tues.
morning. The Tanners come
over and bid us good bye.
I went over to say good bye
to Mrs. Kropp from he
talked with Boddely near
our trailer. We went over
to the Nabers for the
evening. She served butter
scotch pie and coffee got
home around 10:00.

Mar 25

Got up around 5:00 and

stopped at a roadside

- Stopped at a Rest area in Virginia for our lunch and nap around 12:30. I warmed up some soup.

Drove to Quantico and looked around. Then to Mt Vernon.

Got there about 4:00 PM and left 5:30. Just got about three miles from Mt Vernon and stopped at Gas station to inquire about place to stay all night. The man was very kind and helpful and said we could stay there. He backed the trailer

in for us and got the lights
and water hooked up for us.
Mar 30

Left gas station near Mt Vernon
at 9:45. stopped in Toneytown
and mailed a card to Amy.
Got to Gettysburg around
1:00 had lunch and then
hunted for a place to
leave trailer and stay
all night. Found a place
6 miles from Gettysburg,
upon a hill the wind
blew so hard while we
tried to rest so afraid
trailer might blow over
so ask if we could
move trailer down the hill
moved it and then drove
to Gettysburg to cemetery.

April 1
