Sun. Jan. 17, 1970

We left home at 8:30 Sat.,
morning Jan 17. Got to Hodson's
around 10:00 had lunch,
and left around 1:00 p.m.

It was snowing and the roads
were quite bad.
Stayed over night about 21
miles from Louisville.

We ate supper at Franklinton,
at a Horne's restaurant

Sun Jan. 18

Lift around 7:00 A.M. Had a noise
in our car stopped at gas station
but they didn't have anyone that
could tell what it was. Stopped
at Shepherdsville Kentucky and
they knew what was wrong
and got it fixed in about an
hour and charged us \$4.00

Had supper at Holiday Inn
and stayed all night at Macon.

Georgia.

The roads were slippery.

and we had fog near.

Chattanooga could not see
more than 2 car lengths ahead,
we drove over 500 miles.

Jan 19 Mon.

We left around 7:30 AM and
stopped at the welcome center
at the Florida line. We stopped
at Silver Springs ^{at 1:50} and enjoyed
the ride on the glass bottom
boat. We arrived at Rainbow
Springs around 5:30. Got
set up and then went down
to Zephyrhills for dinner at
restaurant across from post office.
It was \$1.49 per person, could
have all you wanted to eat.

Jan 20 Tues,

We left the trailer around 10:00 went to Cypress Gardens and Bok Tower. Got home around 5:30 Gordon and Mary went to Tampa for supper. They got home around 10:00 we went to bed at 9:00

Jan 21 Wed.

We went down to Zephyrhills to the Bank, Chamber of Commerce and post office. Got our first mail. one from Dorothy and some other letters of not much importance. Mary stayed home and got her suitcase packed.

We came back and got loaded and went to Busch Garden. Got there around 11:45 and watched the parrot show at 1:00 had lunch and then Gordon and Mary walked around some more.

and we sat on beach, we took them to airport around 4:00. Their plane was to leave at 6:00.


We got home around 5:00 we took a rest and then went to the Hall to see slides.

Jan 22 Thurs.

I washed the car and trailer. They were really dirty. was going to do a little washing but tired when I got done. Had nap in afternoon. after supper went over to Bill Hallbauer from 7:00 until 10:30. Daddy put up the mail box today.

Jan 23 Fri.

Wrote a card to Gordon & Mary and Daddy wrote a long



letter to Amy a line of
our trip down and while
Gordon & Mary were here.
It rained a little around
noon so they couldn't have
their turkey shoot.

We went down to Zephyrhills
got a loaf of white bread
and 1 loaf Cuban bread it was
about 37 in long, at Cash &
Carry store. Went to post
office to see if we had
any mail.

Then went to hunt up the
Tanners. Had a nice visit
with them. It rained again
a little at night. Went to
bed around 8:30 as Noddy was
so tired.

Jan 24 Sat.

Got up around 7:15. I put

some blankets on to wash
before we had breakfast.
It looks like a nice sunny
day this morning. Temperature
around 40° at 7:00 o'clock.
We went up to schuffle board
and they played turkey
because it rained on Fri.
when they are suppose to.
We got 2 state journals
today for the first,
govt. 25

We went to Methodist church
at 11:50. The church was
packed. After church went over
to see the Kopp's but they
were away for the day.
Saw a lady that was
staying with Mrs. Kopp's sister
a brother. She gave us a
sack of oranges.
Had dinner and nap and then

Looked up the Mike &
from Hastings
Visited them a couple hours.
It was a beautiful day.

Jan 26.

Another beautiful day. Did
not need a sweater on
early in the morning. I put
sheets on our bed and washed
the blankets and all of my
washings.

Did not get any mail not
even a paper.

We went to Zephyrhills and
got 1 bu grapefruit and went
out on 5th and got a bottle of
gas.

We took a walk in park
and met some people from
Virginia near Dick Ramsey's
home.

Came home and played

Rack-o and Daddy beat
every game.

Jan 27 - Tues.

Went to see The Knapps.
We was in Zephyrville fishing
horse show. But she was
there.

Came home and we got 5
State Journals and some letters.
Had turkey shoot this afternoon
and Daddy got 27.

It has been a real warm
day, 59° at 7:00 this morning.
Went over to see the
Coddwells in the evening but
they were over to their
neighbors playing cards.

Tried to find the Lawrence
Smith's but got on wrong
street. Found Mr. Fluvemore
from Mason and had a long
talk with him before looking



up the smoke.

Got home around 10:00 P.M.
on 28 Wed.

A beautiful day. It was 60°
this morning.

We went up for coffee
and rolls at 10:00 AM,

Doddy is on the committee
for next wed. morning.

Had potluck at Hall last night
Had a nice supper. Around 50
people there.

Came home and read the paper
until bed time.

on 29 Thurs.

Another beautiful day. Wined
and wrote a card to Lou &
Mabel Knopf. Went down to
Zephyr and Doddy went to
Zephyr news and I'm getting the
paper for 3 months. Got gifts
for Bridge party. Fri night.

The Hallbaus came over
for a little while and we
sat outside.

In evening some people from
Virginia spent the evening
with us. We sat outside
and Daddy played the tape
about the Dow post office to
them.

Got a letter from Louise
for 30 Frs.

Looks like rain today.

I wrote a card to Georges
and Bruce.

Daddy played on the turkey
short.

We went to Biogr at the
Hall for the evening.

I won a box of Kleenex and
Charles showed curtain books.
It was getting real cold when
we came home!

Jan 31 Sat.

Temperature around 34° this morning. Had 3 blankets on and couldn't keep warm. The night before had just the sheet over us part of the night.

Went to Zephyr for groceries. Had a long nap. So cold no one wanted to play shuffle. Mr & Mrs ^{Paul} Knapp visited us in trailer for a while in evening. We then played rackets until 9:30 I beat the most times.

Feb 1 Sun.

Another cold morning. We went to Methodist church. There were 42 song in the choir. They have white robes with green.

afternoon had long nap. Went to see Bruce Tidwell. Robert

Kopps and Verne Taylor's
Came home played cards
and had lunch and went
to bed.

Feb. 2 Mon.

It started raining towards
morning. Rained hard most
of the forenoon. Thundered and
lightened. Stayed inside
most of the day. The Cadwells
came over and told us they
got a letter from Louis
Metzouth.

We drove into Zephyrhills
and looked up Jack
Stoutenburg who used to
live in Okemos next to
Leonards.

Played Racks in the evening
and Haddley won most of
the games.

Feb 3 Tues

It rained most of the night
and in the morning had a
closed burst. Had tornado
warnings out. We had about
2 ins of water under our
trailer around morning but it
didn't last long.

Stayed inside all day and
worked on appon.

I won some of the games
last night at rocko.

Feb 4 Wed.

Got up around 6:30. Got my
washing started at 7:00 and
when I put the clothes on
line they froze stiff. It was
a cold night. I suppose to
stay cold all day.

Mabely is on the committee
to get Rollie and make

coffee for the coffee hour this morning. He and Elmer Hogg. The truck was late bringing the rolls. There were around 35 come for coffee talked about their hobby show next 7 m.

They played turkey shoot as it was wet the day before. Mrs Knapp come over for a little while.

I baked potatoes in my new electric oven. It baked them real good.

We played rackets again in the evening.

Feb. 5 Thurs.

Got up about 6:30 and put up a lunch and went to Florida State Fair at Tampa. Invited the Nabus but

he was sick with the flu.
There seems to be several
in the park with the flu.
We left around 8:45, and it
was 10:30 by the time we
found a parking place and
got into the fair grounds.
Spent most of the time in
chicken house. Saw dogs
perform in front of grandstand.
It cost .60. q to get in to
fair and the grandstand was
free. It was Senior Citizens
Day. We got home around
5:00 P.M.

We were both tired and had
a nap.

Feb 6

A little warmer today.
We went to sidewalk sale
and to He-N-Hi mobile
Hobby show. Got groceries and

grapefruit. Dr. after noon was
turkey shoot. Got a letter
from Amy that she got home
on Fri Jan 30. Also got a
letter from Mary Lou Ramsey.
Took letter from Amy
over to Cadwells for Dr
to read. Visited for about
1 hr.

Feb 7 Sat.

Cloudy this morning.
We went to Michigan Review
at Zephyrhills Municipal
Buildings. It was a very
nice affair around 600
people. The program was
very interesting. I sat beside
a lady from Rockford,
Waddly beside a lady from
Pontiac. The people across
the table received the juic

for the number of years married
62 yrs.

Feb 8 Sun.

Went to the First Christian Church. It is a new church just dedicated a week ago. Elmer Hoage go to this church and he was telling Charles about it. It was communion Day and they had some what of a difference way in their service. This church had dark wood and blue carpet and chairs. The pews had green cushions. In afternoon had a nap and then visited with the Zebbs

Feb 9 Mon

Went to Webster about 30 miles from Zephyr. They have this every Mon. They sell all the old antique things you could think

of. 3 long building and 1 shorter building. They had a glass jar for \$12.00 it was 1896.

They had one long building with vegetables & fruits.

Lots of sweet potatoes, peanuts, turnips and cabbage with long the leaves left on. They cook it all. tomatoes. They get big prices for their artiques but more people were looking rather than buying. It was a beautiful day. we ate our lunch in car and then went to the Glade Battlefield near Bushnell Florida. The grounds were very nice. Charles went in the Museum.

It rained a little on way home.

I worked before going and my clothes were on the line but mrs. Lewis took them down

so they were O.K.
Charles went over and visited
with Fred Murphy for about $1\frac{1}{2}$
hours in the evening about
turkeys.

Feb 10, Tues.

We went down town and
got gas in car went to post office
and Bank and then to Robert
Kopps for a little while. He
gave us a bag of oranges
and grapefruits.
Today was turkey shoot
again.

It has been nice but a cold
wind suppose to get cold
tonight. Had to light furnace

Feb 11 Wed.

Had my hair done at 9:30

Was not pleased with the
way she fixed it. Got
groceries and in the afternoon
Charles got both gas.
It has been nice today
around 70°

Feb 12 Thurs.

I made cookies for to take
1 day to Hobby store and
bake sale. Made oatmeal
and it took about 2 hours
to bake a batch.

Mrs Hallbauer came and
gave me a name of lady
who would ^{like} me to work
for her wanted me on Fri
In Evening Bill Hallbauer came
and said for me not to
go on Fri as her husband
came home with the flu
In afternoon I shopped
with Charles the first I had



tried this year.

Feb 13 Sun.

A beautiful morning. Took cookies up to Hall around 9:00 AM. They had some very nice things that the ladies and men made.

Charles went out to turkey farm with Fred Murphy.

I visited with Mrs Prokes and Mrs Knapp in their trailer. Charles played shuffle board and I went up to the Hobby show again. While at Hall the Walt Sheldons came. They saw Charles out at shuffle board. They stayed until around 5:30.

Feb 14 Sat.

Went down to Zephyr got a bushel of grapefruit, groceries and in afternoon noon

Charles played shuffle until around 5:00. I hadn't had a nap. Came home and Fred Murphy wanted us to take him to a so he didn't get a nap so went to bed early. I made us the table bed for me to sleep on, and I rested the best I had since I came down.

July 15 Sun. Dad not go to church. Started for a walk but didn't get far. Charles saw a trailer parked at a house close to Trails Court with Michigan license. They were from near where Margaret Musbach lived for a few years. We visited with them over an hour.

Had dinner and had a nap.
and while resting the Lawrence
Smiths' came.

In evening started for another
walk and saw Mr.
and he invited us to come
over to his trailer. We
stayed and visited until around
8:00 P.M.

Feb 16 Mon.

Left Court around 8:30
to see some people at
Clearwater. Stopped at 4 different
places. Two families were
sick, one had moved away
and the other family had the
wrong name. We then went
to John Lucius and they
were home. It started to rain
when we got there and rained
hard all the way home and
most of the evening.

We played cards for a little while after reading the paper.
Feb 17 Tues.

I washed today. It was raining around daylight but it cleared up some so decided to wash. Haven't had my hot smile Sat. morning.

Got clothes about dry before a little shower came up afterlunch.

Went over to Cooks for a little while in evening.

Feb 18 wed

Cloudy this morning Temperature 55° at 7:00 A.M.

Had coffee at Hall at 10:00 They played turkey in afternoon as Tues. was cold and damp.

Charles shuffled until around four, had nap. Went to American Legion meeting in evening. It was real nice and warm in afternoon but got cool when the sun went down.

Feb 19 Thurs

Foggy this morning Temperature 49° at 7:00 A.M.

Got Groceries, eggs, gifts for Bruno.

Charles played shuffle and we went for a little walk. Played rachro for a while.

Feb 20 Fri,

Temperature around 56° We went out to Hallbauer's in forenoon. Afternoon was turkey shoot. Nice day but cold wind. Charles got his hair

cut and I walked the streets
and looked in a dress shop.
Mr & Mrs Wickman come
over in evening and played
racks. The soon
Feb 21 Sat.

nice but cool today, went
over to Kappa in Brown
and got Groceries,
afternoon Charles played
shuffle. Had a fire in
the woods caused by
someone along the road
threw out cigarette all the
men went with shovels
and brooms and soon had
it out.

We went out to Hallibars
to get Charles cap he left
the day before.

Feb 22 Sun

A nice bright morning but cool.

Went to the Baptist Church. Church was full. The choir wore first clored gowns with yellow collars, 18 in choir.

Mr. and Mrs. Curtis called on us in afternoon. They brought a house at Port Pickey. Charles played shuffle board for a while and I visited the Knapp's, and Mrs. Bacon.

Went with the Hallbaums for potluck supper at their church. They showed a movie Crusade for Christ.

It was a beautiful day in the sun but a cool wind.

Feb 23 Mon

Lift here around 8:15 for Disney land. Took Mr & Mrs.

Eli Woodard with us. Got lost. Took the first Kessinger exit and should have taken the second. Went 31 miles out of our way.

Got home a 1:00 p.m. It was a beautiful day. It will be 30,000 acres when completed. Will have part of it open in Oct. of 1971.

Feb 24 Tues.

Washed in the morning.

Got groceries. Saw some people at shopping center that live at Sturges Mich. They knew Bill Glubaugh and his sister. Turkey shoot in afternoon. Got 3 paper so also prepared all evening.

Beautiful wash day.

Feb 25 Wed.

Coffee hr. at the Hall
after coffee the Goodrich's
and us set up the tables
and put paper on them for
the potluck at night.

It rained from noon on
quite a little. We went up
to the Hall again at 5:15.
Had a nice supper.

Hot home at 7:30 after doing
up the dishes.

Played racking until 9:30

Feb 26 Thurs.

Quite a bit colder this
morning. Cold North wind.

Charles looked up the Ray
Sott lonely from Moon Hill
a long visit with them and
they would like to read
our state journals.

Feb 27 Fri

It was a cold night, 28 at 6:00 A.M. were bad frost all over car and wind shield could scare ice off. It warmed up during the day and was real nice in afternoon for turkey shoot.

After our trip took State Journal over to Lott's. Went out to Hallbauer's in evening. Got home about 10:15 invited them for dinner Sunday.

Feb 28 Sat

Not so cold last night. I made a coffee cake this morning.

Did not do anything special. Took a lady from York with us to get Groceries. Ellen Knechen. Played rackets at Watertown.

and go to the post office. She wanted to get in the Bank but it was closed all day.

Mar 1 Sun

Went to Baptist church a crowded house. A beautiful day, stopped and got 3 boxes of Broasted chicken and we had the Hallbaums for dinner. They took us over to Lakeland. They wanted to see a couple friends that were in Hospital. Found one had gone home on Sat. so looked him up in trailer court. Also went to a large store Fields in Lakeland. Saw three of the several lakes they have in Lakeland. Went to bed early as Charles did not get a nap.

Mar 2 Mon

Wasted early. The machine
was kept busy from 7:00
until after 1:00 a beautiful
day, Charles played shuffle
and I visited Mrs. Rusch
for a while. Helped her take
her laundry home and she
showed me through her
trailer. Charles visited a
chicken farm in forenoon.
Trailer came in about 5:00
Holiday trailer from Mich.
Hot steaks took about 3 hours
to get them out.

Mar 3 Tues

Took Mrs. Naber and Mrs.
Ellen Hinchen with us to
the Strawberry Festival at
Plant City. A beautiful day
Left around 10:00 & arrived
got a seat by curb around
11:00.



a very nice parade lasted
1 hr 50 mins. around 24 Bonds,
Ellen Hocken and Mrs Haber
treated us to dinner at
Zephyrhills after the parade.
Not through eating around
4:00. Come home had a nap,
Went up to shuffle around
6:00 Charles and Harry Brown
Al Haerty son-in-law
visiting from Wall Lake,
and Al Haerty and I played
against them. Al and I won
2 games.

Mar 4 Wed

A beautiful morning. Went
up for coffee and had a
meeting to discuss about
potluck for March and about
the \$5.00 that was suppose
to go for flowers of someone
was sick.

In afternoon had turkey shoot because of parade on Tues, we went up and shuffed together in evening. It was 67° when we come home at 7:30

Started to rain a little before we went to bed.

Mar 5 Thurs

Rained hard from the time we got up until around 10:00 o'clock. Everything was flooded around trailer and down to the garbage cans. Afternoon we had nap and got groceries, went to Bank and post office. Took some State Journals to Rayette and visited around $1\frac{1}{2}$ hours. Came home and put potatoes in

to bake.

Went to bed early.

Mar 6 Thu

Got up and started to work at Mrs. Howard Johnson's at 8:00 worked until 11:30. Had lunch. This was turkey shoot day. It has been a beautiful day but glad to stay in the shade. Bingo tonight at the Hall I won a cup with paper containers and Charles won a plastic doiley.

Got home around 10:00

Mar 7 Sat.

Got my hair cut and hair set at 10:00.

Started to rain around four. We went to the flower show at Zephyr Park. The eclipse of the sun was

around 1:19 p.m. Got dark
but not real dark.

Did not do anything in
evening as it rained all night
Charles went over a few
minutes to say good bye
to Elmer Haags and they
plan to leave for home
Monday.

Mar 8 Sun,

Planned to drive down to
Elsie's at Venice. But Charles
was not feeling too good had
difficulty spelling and could see
double once in a while so
decided while eating breakfast
not to go. called Elsie at
11:30 AM. we checked about
a Dr. and decided to go
to Nook City in the morning
to the clinic.

We drove over to Hallbourns
but they were away.

Then drove around some of
the side roads.

about 8:00 o'clock Took
records over to Ellen
Hinchey and Charles played
the tape about the Dow
postoffice. we got home about
10:00.

Mar 9 Mon

Got up early and drove into
Dodge City about 8:30
Charles had his blood pressure
taken it was 190. Made
appointment for 3:15 P.M.

There to see a Dr.

Charles went after both
gas and stopped to see the
Chadwells. I got busy and
got my working done and
on the line.

It was cloudy part of the
forenoon so didn't know

weather to wash or not this morning. But it turned out to be a beautiful afternoon.

Charles played shuffle in afternoon and we played rukko in evening and I won

Mar 10 Tues.

Went to the Fondue Parade at Zephyrhills, at 9:00 o'clock parade started at 10:00

Charles rode in the parade

Went to Nade City to Dr. in the afternoon. Charles blood pressure was 190

It was real hot in the sun.

Mar 11 Wed

Coffee house and meeting at the Hall.

Rained hard from about 4:00 to 9:00^{PM} o'clock.

Went down to Drug store
after medicine. Sat in car a
while before starting back home
as it just rained.

Played cards for about 1 hr.
Visited a while with Mrs.
Bacon an afternoon while
Charles shuffled.

Mar 12 Thurs.

A nice morning, 64° Radio
said 40 per cent rain. Talked about
going to baseball game but gave
it up. Charlie went to see
a chicken man.

It got up to 82° it was
really hot in trailer. We
played shuffle a little
while before supper. It
didn't rain.

Mar 13 Fri

I worked $3\frac{1}{2}$ hrs for Mr
Howard Johnson. Neddy went

out to Turkey farm, with Fred Murphy.

I had Turkey shoot in afternoon
Noddy won the trophy for the day with 45 points. I had his picture taken with me.
Climber Wertenburg who won the trophy for the ladies.
It has been cool today.

In the 60

Mar 14 Sat

a real cool morning, but car oiled & greased. I drove around looking up a place to get grapefruit & oranges to take home, stopped in the Robert Kopp's a few minutes and they gave us some grapefruit and oranges. Got groceries. Had ray in afternoon. Charles played shuffle until 5:30, I made

a coffee cake and baked a
turkey roll. Invited the Habus
over for the evening to play
Rocko, Mrs. Nibbe Won. I served
coffee and coffee cake. Haddy
played the recording about the
How post office. They left
around 8:15 P.M.

Mar 15 Sun

Went to Methodist church.
It has been cool all day.
Drove out to Hallbauer's
and Lawrence Smiths and
Hunemores but everyone
gone away. Stopped on the
way home to art gallery.
They had show on Sat. and today
but they had closed up at
5:00 P.M. They let us in.
They sell artificial flowers,
also rent flowers.

They use artificial flowers
for weddings. Rent the large
bouquets and buy the corsages
and wedding flowers sometimes.
They rent from \$2 to \$5.00

Doddy went up to watch
them shuffle for a little
while. I went along but didn't
stay as it was so cold.

March 16 Mon

Had my washing on the line
at 7:30. Cool first thing
but the sun came out
and it is nice in the sun.
Charles went to turkey farm
to see them take a batch
off. I cooked beans for bean
soup.

Charles shuffled in afternoon.
I beat him at rocko in
evening.

Mar 17. Tues.

Charles went to Dr. again today at Dodge City. Ellin went with us to get a physical for the peace cor. but Dr. said she better go to Tampa to the Health Center. Turkey shoot in afternoon, went after a few groceries and stopped to see Lawrence Smith's and Earl Howemore.

Mar 18 Wed.

Looks like a beautiful day, 60° at 7:00 AM. coffee this morning at 10:00. Mr and Mrs. M. E. Shattuck from Detroit who are staying at St Peterburg were here a couple hours this afternoon. Mr. & Mrs. Cook from Trailor Court came over for a little while. Charles went to American Legion meeting tonight.

It was real warm. 85° in
the shade. We sat out on
the patio most of the afternoon.

Mar 19 Thurs.

A real nice day. Kirkpatrick
came about around 10:00 AM
did not stay long. We walked
up to the orchard. Harry
was anxious to get going.
We had cook out in park
at 1:00. Me lowe cooked
the hamburgs and weenies.
Lots to eat. In afternoon

Charles played shuffle and
around 5:30 the Bruce
drove in for a short time.
In evening Mabus stopped
in and visited for a while
and then Wickerman, came
and stayed until 9:00

Mar 20 Fri

It was real hot today.

I worked ¹/₂ day. They said they hated ² to have me go and would like me next year if I come back. Also another lady would like me. Turkey shoot in afternoon. The last for the season.

Gene Louis won for the men and Mrs. Climber Wurberg cho ladies.

Charles and I went up and shot turkey until 8:00 o'clock. Some played cards at the Hall. It was a beautiful night.

Marie sat.

We went down to get some egg cases to take our fruit back in.

Went out to Hallbauer for a while in afternoon.

Another hot day,
Went over to Fred Koehne's
in evening for a little while.
She has been sick for a
couple of weeks. Went up
to see them shuffle and
they were just quieting so
took a little walk and
stopped and talked with
Leslie Car.

Mar 22 Sun

Charles got up early and
taped the mocking birds.
It started raining around
7:00 came down real hard
for about $\frac{1}{2}$ hr and then
stopped.

Walk to the Nazarene
Church today. They have a
new church! Blue carpet
and cushions are blue.
artificial flowers. Blue in
center. 2 pots with leaves

on each side.
Had a man that led the
singing, played organ and
piano together. Mixed
choir men, women young and
teenage children.

Mar 23 Mon

a cold night and cold
today. But nice and bright
I washed and got my clothes
dry by noon.

Charles went out to Turkey
farm and watched them
dress turkeys. Came home
had lunch around 11:00 and
got ready to go to Lakeland
to the Tiger and New
York ball game. Mr. Meier
and Mr. Cook went with
him. The score was 5-2
in favor of New York.
