Trip to Florida 1971

Jan 5

We left home at 8:25 AM.
Took David Whalys car
to Metro air port and
left it. Had to stop and
get air filter and new
spark plugs.

We ate lunch in car while
driving. Stayed all night
in Lexington Kentucky.

Got set up around 7:30

Very cold around 8 above
Had heater on all night
and couldn't keep warm.

Jan 6

We left Kentucky around
7:40 AM. Had a real nice
day roads dry. We stayed
all night at Macon Georgia
Stopped at 6:00 P.M.

It was nice temperature,
just wore our sweaters.
Did not freeze that night.

Jan 7

We left Macon at 7:10
A.M. We ate in car
again. We stopped at
Silver Springs. Dave and
Carol took boat trip
and Charles & I took a
nap. We got to Rainbow
Mobile Court at 4:00 P.M.
Dave got the jacks under
trailer, aerial up and
then we went into
Zephyrhills mailed some
cards and got $\frac{1}{2}$ bu oranges
and $\frac{1}{2}$ bu of grapefruit.
Dave paid for them 1.25
Came home had supper
and was in bed by 9:00 PM

Jan 8

Left the Trailer Court about 8:30. Went to post office made out cards to have mail changed. Picked up our mail.

Took Hlave and Carol to Tampa airport. Got back to Zephyrhills at 11:40. Stopped at Chamber of Commerce to have our name put in paper. It took around 55 minutes from Air port to Zephyrhills.

Went up to the Hall to see slides. Mr Wride from Trailer Court showed them of England, Germany and France. Had coffee & cookies

Jan 9

I washed two loads of

Cloths, it looked like rain
We went out to Hallbauer
about 10:00 Had coffee
pumpkin bread and cookies.
Come home had lunch and
it began to rain around
1:30. I got my cloths
about dry.

Jan 10

Went to the Methodist
Church. Had dinner, nap
and called on the The
Bacons in our trailer
Court.

Jan 11

Washed one load of cloths
Had not dry very good,
The lines were full.
Went to Zephyrhills to
Bank, postoffice, Got $\frac{1}{2}$ bu
grapefruit, 1 doz eggs and
went to grocery store

and drug store.

Charles shuffled in afternoon
We took a walk to see
Marks new Mobile home
but he wasn't there. Stopped
at Claude Brown for a
few minutes. She showed
me their mobile home.

Jan 12.

We drove down to Zephyr
to the postoffice as we did
not get any mail in our
mail box.

They had 5 State journals
letter from Barbara, Dorothy
Marjorie and few others.
When we got back Clare
Bidwell and his wife were
just leaving. They stayed
a couple hours and we
sat out side. Charles went
to bed early as his back

hurt him.

Jan 13.

I wrote a letter to Barbara & Bob. Went up to coffee hour at 10:00 AM. A nice number out and Mr Lowe took our pictures before we left. Had a nap and then Charles went up to shuffle.

Jan 14

Went to Zephyrhills to postoffice to mail Federal Income Tax form to Barbara. It cost 18¢ to send it. Got 2 gifts for Bingo Fri night and a few groceries.

Drove out to Ray Knapp. He wasn't there but came before we left. I looked on afghan in afternoon and Charles

shuffled 5 games.

We played ratho in evening
and I won.

Jan 15.

Furnished up Income tax
and mailed.

Charles slept most of the
day. Having back trouble.
Fell out of bed a couple
days ago.

I wrapped gifts for bingie
we went up to bingie
party in evening. Had
coffee and crackers &
cookies.

Jan 16.

Washed cloths. Had a
nice drying day. It was
cool this morning. Around
40°.

Went in to Zephyr hills
and mailed recording to
Barbara & Bob.

Went and called on the
Kroops. They gave us
oranges and lettuce.

Jan 17

Had a frost last night
Had heat all day. The
coldest day since we
arrived.

Charles back bothered him
he stayed in bed most
of the day.

Did not go to church.
I wrote letters and cards.

Jan 18

Did not do much in
forenoon. Afternoon I practiced
shuffling. Charles played
a few games.

I worked on Afghan and
in evening we played
racks. I beat. 9 to 4

Jan 19.

Had car oil and Lub.
Got groceries and then
looked up. Mrs Wentus.
Was surprised to have
Mrs. Hreps come to door.
We visited about 1 hour.
We had our first Turkey
shoot in afternoon. I
entered this year. I
got 36 points the next to
the highest score.
Charles got 25 points.

Jan 20.

We went after a bottle
of gas and then called
on the Ray Lotts.

It was real cool in
afternoon and evening. Had
a light frost this morning.

Jan 21

We had all the blankets

we had over us. Left the
gas heat on all night
and around morning put
the electric pad in bed
to keep us warm.
It was 22° . Frost all
over car. Had to scrape
it off of the back
windows before going
after another tank of
gas. Got gas and then
groceries and a few
other things. Got home
about 11:00. Found a note
that Mrs Vera Lee a
friend of Marjorie's was
here visiting some friends
Vertel Van Camp.

Charles thought we better
go right in and look them
up. It was lunch time

and they are just sitting
down to eat bean soup.

They invited us to stay
Mrs Lee got to know
Marjorie thought the Rev
Boekus who was
minister in Brown City
The Van Camps lived
in Brown City and they
both knew Donald Bruce's
parents.

The Van Camps son lives
in Marlette and knows
Dorothy and Stan.
Had a real nice visit.
Come home had a nap and
Charles played shuffle for
a while. He went to bed
early but I watched T.V.
until 9:00 Family affairs
and Jim Nabors.
Jan. 22

Did not do much in forenoon. It was warmer and seemed good. In afternoon had Turkey shoot and I got 0. In evening we played rackets and Charles won. It wasn't my day.

Jan 23.

I washed had a very nice day to get clothes dry.

We called on the Laurence Smiths in forenoon.

Charles shuffled a while in afternoon.

He went to bed early and I watched TV until 9:00

Jan 24

We went to Methodist Church. Saw the Codwells and Weeks.

I wrote a letter to Dove

Cook and Louisa,

Jan 25

I washed the car and Charles and I went up and shuffled right after lunch wanted to in the forenoon but there was such a heavy dew the coat did not dry off until noon.

Jan 26

Went to Zephyrhills for groceries, medicine and the Bank.

Had turkey shoot in afternoon I made 14 and Charles 34

Jan 27

We left for Lakeland around 9:30 for the East Lansing Picnic at Sears Town Restaurant got there about 10:15 and found out it would be

around 11:00 before they
come. We saw quite a
few people we knew
something about.

Had a real nice dinner
got home around 2:30

It will be at the same
place and the last Wed in
Jan. next year again.
Jan 28

We did not do much
today. Went up around
12:30 and Charles and I
practical turkey shoot
for a while then Mrs
Joe Gerkin came over
and she and I played
for a while.

Jan 29.

Went after gas as our
tanks went dry at supper
time. Got a few groceries

and went to Hall for pot-
luck at 5:30. There were

63 at the supper. Had
lots to eat. Came home
and watched T.V. most
of the evening.

Charles went to bed early.
Jan 30.

I washed today. Had a
real good drying day. The
lines were full most of
the time. I was the
first to have clothes on
the line.

Went out to Hallbauer's
in afternoon. She was
busy making drapes.
Came home and Charles
played shuffle until around
5:00

Got a letter from Barbara
and 3 pictures.

Jan 31

Went to Methodist Church,
Got there 20 minutes before
church and had to sit
next to the back row.
Watched the Apollo 14
on T.V.

Took a walk around park,
watched T.V. until 9:00
It rained just a little
in the evening.

Feb 1

We went down to
Zephyrhills to see about
getting some one to fix my
iron. A lady in a
electric store found a
man in Winter Park
that would fix it after
making three telephone
calls. W. W. La. Rue

255 Suzanne Ave.

Stopped to see Mrs. Emma Schaffer that lived in the Hicks subdivision years ago. Mrs. Carl Hicks told us about her living on 1011 6th Ave Zephyrhills, Feb 2

We had turkey shoot again in afternoon I got 25 points.

Having some nice weather again.

Feb 3

Went down early to pick up my iron, get medicine and a few groceries. Got back in time for coffee hour. After coffee Charles shuffled and Mrs. W and I practiced turkey shoot until around 11:00

We played rabiw until
bed time. It was a
beautiful night. Several were
out walking until bed time,
Feb 4.

Got up about 7:00 Got
my ironing done from the
week before and went out
to see about picking
strawberries next to Knapps.
Saw the ad in the paper,
They wanted some one to
pick for the season.
We visited with the
Ray Knappas for a couple
of hours.
Got a tape from Barbara
and Bob today. We did
not bring our recorder this
year.

Feb 5

It was 60° this morning
I washed out a few things
by hand.

Charles and I practiced
turkey shoot for about an
hour in the forenoon.

We had turkey shoot in
afternoon. My score was
40 next to the highest
Mrs. Wartenburg got 43

It rained a little towards
night but we got a nice
hike in the evening.

The most rain since we
arrived.

Watched TV for a while.

Feb 6

We went to the Mich
picnic. The Laths were
the only ones we knew
except 3 couples in our

trailer count. I took
thermos bottle with coffee.
It tipped over in car
and broke just as we
were getting out to main
Road.

There were 525 present
at picnic. Had a nice
dinner and program.

Ray Knapps came while
we were gone and left
2 qts strawberries with
Mrs. Lewis next door.

It was such a nice
evening we walked around
and visited on the road.
Missed part of Lawrence
Welch show.

Feb 7.

Went to Methodist church

It was nice and warm.

Came home had dinner and
nap.

Mrs & Mrs. George Curtis
called on us about 5:00
It started raining hard
They stayed until 6:30
waiting for it to let up
but they left in the
rain to go call on
Leslie Carr's

It rained all night real
hard. Flooded the wash
room floor. Made a large
hole under trailer near
tongue. Had a bad storm
at Gainesville and St.
Augustine.

Feb 8

It rained most of the
morning. Cleared up around
noon.

Clare Bidwells visited us

in afternoon. After they
left we went to Bank
and grocery store.

Got a phone call around
5:00 P.M. from Gordon
saying we have a new
Granddaughter Born Feb-8
2:00 A.M. weighed $8\frac{1}{4}$ lbs
name Julia Ann.

Watched TV until 9:00
Made a deal and Newly
Weds,
Feb 9

It was quite cool last
night around 34° this
morning.

I got up and had clothes
washing around 7:00
at 10:00 no one else
had started washing.
Charles and I went up
and practiced turkey shoot

before lunch.

Turkey shoot today I got 22

We got 4 State Journal
and we read some of
those this evening.

I washed my hair.

We put 5 blankets on
us as it was very
cold.

Feb 10

This morning it was 30°
Went up to the coffee
hour. Went over to the
Hobby show at Oak side
They had a real nice show.
Stopped in to Ray Lotts for
a few minutes.

Got grapefruit.

Feb 11

I made cookies for Hobby
show. Took $2\frac{1}{2}$ hours to
batch. In afternoon went after

gas. In evening Charles
slept from 7 until 9 and I
watched TV.

Feb 12

Took cookies up to Hall
around 8:30. A large
crowd was waiting to get
into hall at 9:00.

They had a large bake
sale.

325 people registered at
the door.

It was a very nice day.
Charles helped with the
flea sale outside.

A lady dipped over on
her side in ditch trying
to turn into the park.
Alan pulled her out. The
car looked O.K.

Feb 13

Went down to Zephy. Took
Clair Bidwells jacket to him
that he left here last week.
Did not find them home
and left it with neighbor
across the street.

Got eggs at egg place.
Stopped at Kopp's and
he gave us a sack of
oranges. Got groceries.
Watched T. V. in evening.

Feb 14

Went to Methodist Church
at 11:00 a full house
Sat on front pew.

Had dinner, nap and
took a little walk
around court and stopped
to see Mr & Mrs. Hope.
for about 1 1/2 hours
Had lunch and Charles
slept most of the evening.

It was a cold day.
Feb 15

I washed and got my
clothes dry real fast!

Charles and I shuffled after
lunch until the fellows
started coming to play.
I had nap and played
rucks in evening.

Feb 16

We went to Zephy after
gas for car and postoffice
and grocery store.

We played turkey in
afternoon. I got 40 and
Mrs. Hutchinson got the
same. We had to play
again to break the tie
for the trophy. She got
43 the next time and
I got 35.

Stopped in to Rouse in

evening. She said Mrs.
Hallbauer was in Hospital.

Feb 17.

Went to Wade City this
morning to try to get
an appointment to see
Dr. Brownlee as Charles
blood pressure was 190
over 100 last night. He had
it taken in the park.
Could not get appointment
until May. So got one
with Dr. Deal for Mon
Feb. 22 at 2:30 P.M.

We also wrote to Dr
Zakus.

Mr & Mrs. Hope called on
us in afternoon. After they
left I washed the car.

Did not go to coffee hour
this morning.

Feb 18

We went down to Zephyr
to check on a recorder
so to play the tape that
Barbara sent.

Went to library, auto store
City Clerk's office and she
said that the churches
had them. We went to
Methodist church and they
said that the minister
would bring one to the
church Mon.

Had lunch and nap and
Charles played shuffle
a while.

I watched T.V. Family
affairs and the Nabor show
Charles slept all the
evening.

Feb 19

We wrote cards and
letters and practice turkey

shoot in the morning. In
afternoon was turkey shoot
I got 28 and Mrs Gatz
got 30. I was second
highest. Neither the men
or the women got very
high score for the day.
Art Carr got the trophy
for the men.

Waited until 2:30 for
mail it was real late.
Got a letter from Barbara,
Earl Leonardo, A. Beyers
and Bob Lee. The first
we had heard from
home how everything
was.

Mrs. Henry Hagg called on
me and we sat in laundry
room and Charles tried
to get a nap.

Mrs. Fred Kayne come

over just as we finished
supper and showed us
a picture in their paper
of a accident back in
1910

Mr and Mrs Crothers
was walking by to go
see pictures at hall
and Charles invited them
in. I washed the dishes
and visited with Mrs.
Crothers then we
all went up to Hall
to see pictures Mrs.
Wickles showed. They
were very pretty.

Feb 20

We looked up Mrs Anna
Pearson on Sunnyside
Park. Mrs Beyers wrote
us about her.
We visited about 1 hour and

Thom stopped at Clair
Bidwells. They insisted we
stay for lunch.

We stopped for Groceries
and got home around 2:30
Watched T.V in evening,
Feb 21.

Had not go to church
as Charles did not feel good.
Harold Van Scoten from
Endicott N. York, who was
visiting Jean Lewis came
over and visited about
two hours. I had a hard
time to get my chicken
cooked in time for dinner.
We went up to the
Hall at 7:00 for a song
services and the retired
minister in the park talked
to us. 65 were present.
It was very warm all

day and did not cool
off in the night,

Feb 22

I washed 1 load of clothes
but it looked so dark
did not wash out things
by hand. But it cleared
off and I got them all
dry. It rained a little
in the evening and night.

We went down to Zephyr
to see about listening to
the tape but the Methodist
minister was to bring
his recorder to the church
and he forgot it.

I watched TV. in evening.
and Charles slept.

Feb 23

Turkey shot today.

I am 30 and so did
Charles. Mrs Baker won

the trophy with 34 score,
and Mark won for the
men with a score of 50.
We took a walk after
supper and talked with
the Pirce's and they
walked around the Court
with us. They rented
the Lowe trailer for a
month and are from
New Hampshire.

Feb 24

Today was the Margaret's
Birthday.

We went up for coffee.
After coffee went to
Zephyrhills to play a tape
Barbara and Bob sent
us of their trip to
East Berlin. We played
it at the Methodist

and we figured out what
to have for Bingo Game
Fri night Mar 5th we
are on for that night
We are going to have
yellow and chf. cakes.
Mr & Mrs. Hope come over
and we visited outside
for a while.

Took a walk around
park after supper. I
watched T.V until 9:00
Charles went to bed at 7:30
Feb 26.

It was warm last night,
Had a sheet over us part
of the night. We had
potluck supper at the Hall.
Around 50 came.

Watched T.V in evening.
Feb 27

I washed out colored clothes

we visited with people
while they were washing.
A couple came in Fri
night from Mich. They
were near Chebaming
Went over to Halldorson
while a little while. She
was just getting ready
to cut his hair.

Another hot day around
90°

Feb 28.

We got up early and
went to the 8:30 service
at Methodist Church. Came
home. Had dinner around
12:00 Had a nap and
then tried to keep cool
The little flies bothered
so, out side and it was
so hot in trailer.

Heard that it was 49° in

Lansing yesterday,

Mar 1

Washed this morning.
Went to Zephyrhills
Charles got his hair cut
Had to wait a long
time. Got medicine and
groceries. Went to the
Bank and to Kops
Had turkey shoot in
afternoon. As so many
were going to Strawberry
Festival of Tues
Another very hot day.
Mar 2.

Warm again. The
Carothers from Indiana
left for home yesterday
morning. I ironed early
before it got any warmer.
It was very warm
trying to rest in afternoon

after supper took a walk. Stopped and talked with some people from Pontiac that came in the day before. They invited us in to see their trailer. They have a 26 foot one. They had been in Tucson Arizona most of the winter and they said it was cold. They showed us pictures they took in Arizona and New Mexico.

We then walked up to the shuffle court and watched them play until around eight.

Mar 3

Coffee hour this morning. We invited some people from Chesaning that come

in last week, The Liddells,
but they had plans to
go to Sarasota.

After coffee got Groceries.
It was so hot did not
have anything warm for
lunch.

The wind started blowing
hard about 10:30. Sand,
leaves and everything.

About 3:30 the wind
let up and it began
to rain and it cooled
off and really got cold.
Had a little heat before
going to bed.

Mar 4

Temperature 38° this morn-
ing. Everyone is staying
inside this morning.

Rev. Rambol left this
morning. Got a letter

from Mrs. Kirtpatrick today
saying they are coming
to Floudd for Spring
vacation leaving Mar 18th
Watched T.V. in evening.
and Charles went to
bed at 7:45.

Got out some more
blankets as the report
is frost for tonight.
Mar 5.

Charles watched them
lay blocks for foundation
on Mr. Nabers new
duplex on 17th St in
Zephyr.

I got 2 jellies made for
the Bingo party.

Mrs. Gaedt made cup
cakes. Mr. Gaedt was
sick with a cold so.
Mr. Weeks helped us with

the Bingo.

There were 26 present.

Charles called on some people in Oak side that were neighbors to Charles Mc Kone in Detroit.

Mar 6.

We drove down to see what they had done on Mr. Nabors house but they were not working.

Stopped at store on corner of 5th Ave and 301 that was having Grand opening.

The store was a A & P store and they moved out and some new people took it over. I got bandanas at 9¢ a pound and 2 loaves of bread 10¢ a loaf.

It was just nice

temperature most of the day

Will not need heat in evening. Charles went to bed at 7:30 and I watched T.V. until 9:00.

Mar 7.

Got a nice rain last night. Was planning on going to early church service but when we heard it raining changed our minds. We went to the 11:00 service. Got there about 25 minutes early so got a good seat. The church was packed.

In afternoon called on the Von Camps and Vera Lee was there. Around 6:00 the Lytle came over and showed us where they were planning on going farther down south.

They invited us to come
and see them this summer.

Watched this is my life
and Ed Sullivan.

It was cold again tonight.
Mar 8.

It was 35° this morning
on John Barnes, trailer
I washed had it on the
line by 8:30.

The Lytles pulled out
around 8:00

We went down town
to postoffice Bank and
Grocery store. In afternoon
went to Kirkpatrick's for
grapefruit and Charles
took some pictures of
one of the grapefruit trees
with so many grapefruit
on it. Mrs. He Ward stopped
in and told us she

she had taken her husband
to Lakeland Hospital with
a bad leg.

Mar 9

We went to parade at
Zephyrhills at 10:00 AM
it lasted about an hour,
Had turkey shoot in
afternoon and I got 14
points.

Mr. & Mrs. Ray Latt called
on us in afternoon.

In evening Mrs. Habor
came over to see
about buying yarn and
she stayed about $1\frac{1}{2}$ hrs,
Read the State Journal²
and went to bed. about
9:00.

Mar 10

Went up for coffee, Mr.

Wicks gave a Reading and
Mr. Hope, gave one also.

The Wicks left right
after coffee. They were
going on farther south
and planned to get home
around the first of April.
Took a walk after supper
and met some people
that just came yesterday
from Maine. They had
been over on east coast
and were paying \$60.00 a
month for space.

Mar 11.

It was 55° this morning
and foggy. Mr. De Weard
came home from Hospital
today.

We practiced Turkey shoot
a little while in forenoon.
Charles played a few

games this afternoon
and I crocheted.

Got a letter from Louisa,
Ellen, Bennett and Carol
from Dove Cook.

Mar 12

We called on Clair Bidwell
and Laurence Smith.

Turkey shoot in afternoon
I got 22 points and
so did Charles. Mrs
Baker got the trophy
and Frank R. Wood.

It rained some in
evening. Mr. Murphy
took Charles Blood present
Mar 13.

We put signs up
in 3 trailer parks and
got Groceries.

Rained some in evening.

I watched TV until 9:00

Mar 14

Went to church, Got there about 10:20 and the church was getting filled up.

It was real warm all day.

Sat outside and visited with Mrs. Drake and Mrs. Ricker from Mt. Pleasant.

Mar 15,

Washed, Went down town put signs in some trailer. Called about finding some one to drive us home.

Another warm day.

89° on Bank sign

Mar 16

It started raining while we were eating breakfast

Rained off and on most
the forenoon.

Did not have turkey
shoot as court was
wet.

Mar 17.

Coffee hour at 10:00

Came home washed my
hair.

Charles watched them
put a new mobile home
in. They were from
Marie.

Went for a little walk,
Stopped in at Clember
Wartenburgs. To see
her daisy Afghan. To
see if I was doing
mine O.K.

Mar 18

Went down town drove
pass Nabors new house.
They had the floor on.
Stopped and got gas
Went to Chevrolet to
see about tires and they
were busy so said to
come back around 2:00
Got a Thermos bottle
and groceries.

The Joe Perkins are
getting a new mobile
home today.

Went back to Zephyr
to Chevrolet garage around
2:00 P.M. had to wait
about 1 hour before they
got around to check
our car for tires and
points.

Mar 19

We went to see about
grapefruit but no one was
home.

We had turkey stout
in afternoon. I got 15 and
Charles 30 points. The
Bruces stopped in around
6:00. We were just
about through supper,
we went to colored
movies at Hall of Yellow-
stone Park. Mr. Race
from Jackson Mich.
showed them, after movies
had refreshments and
while eating the Kirk-
patrick cards. They
left note at trailer and
then stopped at the Hall
They surprised us.

Mar 20

It was cool today.
I washed out colored
clothes. Drove over to
Hallbauer's and left our
spare tire for them to
store this summer from
our trailer.

Mrs. Nabor brought over
a couple fig cookies for
our lunch.

The wind blew real hard
in afternoon and it
got colder, I watched TV
in evening.

Mar 21

It was cold last night
a little frost on car
windshield this morning.
Several in the park covered
their flowers last night.

We went to Methodist Church at 10:50.

They said last week that they hoped to have their new organ installed for today. But it wasn't quite ready.

They played a record of the 4 choir's songs that the Chorus had sung during the year. They are giving them to people that give \$10.00 or more for the organ fund to finish last payment on the organ.

They played this while people were coming to church. It was very nice.

Mar 22.

I washed early. Didn't look to go but clothes got dry nice. We watched the Cubrys leave about 9:01

Went down town to Bank drove over to Nabors house. They had the blocks there but hadn't started laying blocks. We got grapefruit and Groceries. The Hallbauers were here for supper. I had wanted to have them over all winter but she was in Hospital for two weeks. Charles cut paper to put over windows when we leave.

The Hallbauers left around

8:30 and I had the dishes
to do after that.

Mar. 23

Looks like a beautiful
day.

I have been writing letters
and sending notices to
postoffice, Telephone Co.
Wrote over to say
Goodbye to Bidwells
had lunch. turkey shoot I
got 15 and Charles 23 points
Got a letter from Dorothy.
So wrote one to her
and took it in to post-
office. Stopped at Ray Lotts
for a little while.
I watched Hellbells and
Green Acres

Mar 24

Cloudy this morning but

Warm. Did not need any heat.

Coffee hour at 10:00

The Gierken and Vander
V were in charge
of the coffee.

We took Mrs. Drake down
to shopping center to get
a couple cards.

Went over to watch
them lay blocks at
Ben Nabro new house.
Brought Mrs. Nabro back
with us as he wanted
to stay until a finisher
laying blocks.

Mar 25.

I washed car this
morning.

Today was our cook out
over Vander big tree in
Trailer Court.

It was a beautiful day and around 6:5 were present.
