Jan 7

We got rested a little. When

to get car filled with gas
Got oranges & grapefruit, Groceries
and bath gas.
Got our mail box put up.
Went to bed early as we were
very tired.

Jan 8

Got our trailer leveled up
and on jacks. Eli helped us
put up the T.V. aerial.
We went down after a
few groceries and stopped at
3 motels to inquire about
rooms for Mabel and Ray Knoff.
who are coming down
around the 15th.

We watched T.V. for a while
found that Lawrence Welch
show was on from 7 to 8 on
channel 10

Jan 9

Did not go to church as I
have been having a cold since I
left home, am doing a lot of
coughing,

Jan 10

Wash out a few things
by hand.

Charles got his hair cut
and I went to the Bank
and got checking account fixed
up. Got a few Groceries.
Went to call on the Nabers.
Found they were building
3 new buildings. Getting
one ready to be rented
right away. people were
waiting for it.

The Dytles drove in
yesterday from Chesoning.
They left the same morning
we did. She visited for
a while outside. Charles

went up to shuffle but
there were to many wanting
to play.

Charles went to bed around
6:30 and I watched TV
until 8:30

Jan 11

It was real nice and warm
last night. Had just a
sheet over us until almost
morning.

We went over to call on
the Cadwells and Ray Lotts.
Came home and had lunch
and went to the first turkey
shoot 1:00 I got 15 points
and Charles 17 points.

Howard Kurtz got trophy
and Mrs. Hutchinson.

I took a shower in afternoon
Have been having such a
cold was afraid to before.

Jan 12. It was 69° this morning
and cloudy.
Went up to coffee hour, a large
crowd.
Called on Clare Bidwells and
got a few groceries.

Jan 13

I washed had a good drying
day. I made some vegetable
beef soup.

In afternoon called on Ray C
Pastorius from Lincoln Park.
They lived right near Bidwells
but we didn't know it. The
day before, Charles knew Mrs
Pastorius. They exchanged tapes
from Bud Guest program.

She passed away a year ago.
His wife's sister is living
with him.

We also went to the
Lawrence Smiths but they

were away, stopped at
the Wierds. They were in
our park last year. They
bought a mobile home in Oakside.
Charles went to bed at 6:30
and I watched T.V. until 9:00
Jan 14

It was 71° this morning.

Cloudy and damp.

We went for a little walk.
I went over and visited Mrs
Paul Hague for about 1 hr.
She showed me their new
mobile home.

We played turkey shoot in
afternoon. I got 32 points and
Charles got 32 points.

We played Bingo in the
evening. We each took a
can of fruit or veg.

I won 2 cans of corn. Charles
did not get any.

We got home at 9:45

trailer court and got 1 bu
Navel oranges. They were real
nice 2.50 a bu. Saw Ben
Naber and his grandson over
there. It rained just a
little while we were after
oranges.

Jan 15

We went to Zephyrhills
for groceries and called on
the Laurence Smiths.

It rained most of the
afternoon. It turned colder
at night.

I watched TV until 9:30.

Got a letter from Dorothy
and Louisa.

Mrs. Ward passed away
Jan 12 and the funeral was
today.

Jan 16 It was cold
and windy this morning.
Went to church, a large
crowd. We had chicken for
dinner.

It was around freezing this
morning.

We were over to the
Hallbams this afternoon.

She gave us a dish of
ice cream with Coca Cola
she called it Black cow.

The Tampa paper said it
was below zero everywhere
in Mich this morning.
Watched TV until 9:00

Jan 17

We had 4 blankets over us
last night. Frost on windshield
this morning.

We went down to post office
for stamps.

Had to wait quite a few minutes to get waited on. Went after bottle gas and there was a long line up. Took us 23 minutes.

I made 7 ladies this afternoon. I wrote to Marjorie today and I received a letter from her. Looked for the Roy Knopfs but they haven't arrived. We played rackets in the evening and I beat.

Jan 18

Not as cold last night. It is cloudy this forenoon. Got my income tax ready to send in.

Jan 19

Worked today. Went to coffee hour. The ladies drew names to see who would ride on the float.

Mr. Cook drew a name
out and it was his wife
They told him to draw his
wife and he did
We went down to Zephyrus
after the coffee.

Mailed our income tax
Got Groceries, a card for
the wards.

Went with the Lid over
to Hillside park to watch
some of the people from our
park practice scuffle so
they can compete for the
Senior Citizens Day, Fri and
Sat, Got home about 4:30
watched TV in evening,

Jan 20

Did my ironing and cleaned
out the rest room.

Went up to the hall about
10:00 and helped a little on

the float. In afternoon Mr. Carr started working on gas tank to try to get the green off of it. I helped him some. Charles was ready to go see the Koppa so we called on them.

Jan 21.

There were several ladies washing. Paul Haag and his wife came down and she has a broken hip so I put her clothes in the washer, hung them up and in afternoon after Turkey shoot I took them down. I got 15 points and Charles 22 points. Glayde H got the trophy.

We laid down for a little while and the Koppa came about 3:30. They didn't stay very long as they wanted to

get over to her brothers
mobile home and get it aired
out and furnace going.
We watched TV in evening.

Jan 22

It was raining this morning
early and we were afraid
it might spoil the parade,
but it was cloudy but didn't
rain. The float that Rainbow
had won second prize of
\$15.00. Pinecrest got first prize
of \$25.00

We took Mrs. Wallace with
us. We sat under the roof
by the 10¢ store
Mrs. Drake sat near us also
the Myers.

Jan 23

I went to church saw
the Cardwells when we were
going into the church. Sat

with them in back of church,
Roy and Mabel Knopf came in
and sat in back of us.

Invited the Knopfs home for
dinner. We went over in
afternoon to see Ray Lotte
but did not find them home.
Had lunch and Charles
went to bed at 6:30

Jan 24

We went down to the
Radio station to see about
going to Honey World. They
said that they would be
having another tour Jan
29th. The Knopfs wanted
us to see about tickets
for them. We drove out to
their trailer to tell them,
and we decided to go
too.

I stopped at Bank, got gas

stopped at the radio
station again and got tickets
for Disney World.

It has been a hot day.
At the Radio station they
showed us about how it
works.

Charles played schuffle
a while and I visited
with Mrs. Breke. We sat
out in laundry room trying
to keep cool.

Jan 25

I washed got my clothes
nice and dry. The lines were

around the park and talked

yesterday afternoon from
Richmond Virginia. They
have traveled in every
state but Hawaii and Alaska.

Jan 28

hot in the sun.

We practiced turkey shoot a little in forenoon. Also stopped and visited with Leo. He likes to talk about Gregory.

We talked about the Llanero in Unadilla.

I got 23 points in turkey shoot and Charles got 14 points. Mrs Weeks got the trophy and Claude Brown.

Jan 29

the Sesta Restaurant. Had a
nice dinner. After dinner

went home with them another
3:30. Come home had a nap
and Charles shuffled for a

Jan 31

I planned to wash but changed

a good drying day.

Around 4 or 5 washed but
didn't get their clothes

the Winters. Mrs Winters

We then called on the Van Camps.

Feb 1

Showers all day. We stayed in trailer all day.

It stopped raining around 8:00 P.M.

I worked on afghan.

Feb 2.

I washed white clothes. The report was 30% today and 70% tomorrow rain. I got my clothes dry enough so I dried everything.

Clare Bidwell and his wife called on us early afternoon.

Later in the afternoon we went to Nabers but they were away. Stopped at Veth Taylors and she was there but he was away.

Stopped at Ray Little and stayed until 6:00. Watched TV until 9:30

Feb 3

We drove down to Zephyrville to get a paper with the pictures of the parade in. We stopped at Nabers. He was there but she was in Wade City taking China painting lessons. We stayed and visited about an hour. Stopped to get a few groceries and when we came out of store it was starting to rain. Was raining quite hard by the time we got home. Rained all the

afternoon and turned colder.
We watched TV in evening.
Feb 4

It was a nice bright day
but cool. We all tried to
stay in the sun.

We went down town for
groceries and got pictures
at Drug Store.

Turkey shoot I got 22 points

I furnished fried chicken, frozen peas and ice cream.

We ate in our trailer, after getting dishes done went over to Ray Lott's for about 2 hours. After leaving there. Went to the funeral home it is Fred Murphy who passed away Feb 4th.

Came home Charles slept about 2 hours. We watched TV in evening.

Feb. 7

It rained off and on most of forenoon. Went up to paid our rent and it started to pour. Sat in Lyell's car until it let up a little.

Feb 8

It rained again in forenoon
we called on Mrs Bacon.

Did not think we would have
turkey shoot but it did dry
off in time for shoot.

I got 30 points next to

I looked after Mrs. Goodrich
as Mr. Goodrich had things
to sell. I went in once in a
while to see if she was
O.K. Had a nap in afternoon.
Feb 12

It has been a beautiful
day. Everyone wanted to
wash. Lines were full.

I defrosted refrigerator. Washed
the top of the trailer.

Washed my hair and did my
ironing in forenoon.

Charles shuffled in afternoon.
Feb 13

We went to church. Saw the
Knoffs for a few minutes.

After dinner had nap. The
Vern Taylors called on us
in afternoon. Nice day but cool.

Feb 14

I washed coloured clothes.

The lines were full all day.
It was a nice drying day.
We went to Zephyrhills and
ordered 7 doz doughnuts for
coffee hour. We are on with
the Confers for coffee hour
Wed. Charles got his hair
cut. I went to the Bank and
postoffice. They had the Bank
all trimmed up with oranges
and grapefruit. They gave away
orange juice to everyone.
Came home and Charles and
I practiced turkey shoot
before lunch.
Charles played a few games
of shuffle in afternoon and
I worked on afghan.

Feb 15

Cloudy and it started
raining in afternoon. Several

people washed but did not get their clothes dry.

I wrote 3 letters in the morning. Had turkey shoot in afternoon I got 22 points and Charles 25 points.

Feb 16

We were on the Committee for coffee hour with Ross Conifer ^{and wife} of Muir Mich.

Charles went after the doughnuts and I helped get the coffee started and other things that had to be done. It was raining a little before people came up. Had a real hard rain after we got the dishes done. Waited for about $\frac{1}{2}$ hour before coming home. After getting home around 12:00 it just poured. Came over the flood in laundry

room. It rained all the afternoon. Lawrence Curtis from Newport Richey and his wife stopped for a little while and invited us to come see them next Mon. Feb 17

Looked like rain in early forenoon but I decided to wash and it didn't rain. I got clothes all dry but rug. Anna Whittemore from near Detroit stopped in and showed me her beads and afgan she is making. After she left Mrs. Newell talked out side with us for quite a while. It was 12:30 before I got in to get lunch. Charles and I turkey shot in late afternoon.

Feb 18

I ironed in morning and went down after groceries. also drove to Reynolds orchard for $\frac{1}{2}$ bu of oranges.

We had turkey shoot in afternoon I got 24 points and Charles 25 points.

Had Bingo in evening I won a can of green beans.

Clare Bidwell and wife came over for a short time in afternoon.

The weather man said 70° rain but it was a nice day but the wind was quite cool in P.M.

Feb 19

and eat together Sun.
We went out to Hallbarners
around 4:00 o'clock and
got our spare tire we
left there last spring that
goes on trailer.

Feb. 20.

The Greys come for us
at 10:00 o'clock and
we went to Church. After
Chuck at took us to Plant
City to the Johnson Restaurant
Had a real good dinner.
Have brought us back
and we went to see a
large camphor tree 4 miles
from the park.
after they left we had a

Nap and Mr and Mrs Robert Kopp
come for a few minutes,
after they left we took a
walk and stopped at Paul
Knopps for about 1 hr. Come
back and watched T. V

Feb 21

We left around 9:00 o'clock
for New port Richey to visit
the Lawrence Curtis' It was
40 miles over there. We got
there around 10:00 Talked
about Mrs Curtis relatives and
Charles' Had a nice dinner.
After dinner they took us
to Tarpon Springs and down
to the Gulf. Mrs Curtis and I
walked through several souvenir
shops. They had lots of sponges.
Charles and Lawrence looked at
the boats. We got home at
5:15. Charles was tired.

Feb 22

It was cool this morning but warmed up.

Gene Louis got a new mobile home. We watched them take out old one in forenoon and afternoon watched them put new one in.

About half the people in the park was watching.

We had turkey shortly got 27 points and Charles 32 points

Feb 23

Another nice day for a change. Went up for coffee hr. The girl from radio station talked about trip to Disney World.

After coffee went after bottle gas and went down to Euphyr hills to get air in spare tires and ask about

getting wheels packed on trailer.
The Lewis's invited up over to
see their new Mobile home
just before supper.

Feb 24

I washed and got clothes
dry nicely.

I made 10 daisies. Charles
shuffled in afternoon. I
visited Mrs Paul Haag for a
little while.

Watched T. V. in evening, Saw
President Nixon and wife in
China. It was snowing hard.
in China.

Feb 25

It was another beautiful
day. I washed car and
window on trailer. Fixed
potato salad for pot luck.
The Ray Lotts stopped a minute
with her nephew.

Caltriders, Had turkey
shoot in afternoon. Charles
got 33 points and I got 17
points it was a low day
for everyone.

Had a nice pitbull supper,
came home watched for Nixon
and his wife to get on to
plane at Peking China but
we got tired waiting so
got ready for bed.

Feb 26

It was 57° this morning and
a high humidity.

the 10¢ store to get thread

and beads to make a string
of bead.

Turkey shoot Charles tied
with 3 others 40 points.
Mark, Hutchingston, Eli Woodard.
They played over Hutchingston
got 60 points Charles 43
points.

I got next to the highest 40
points and B. Lewis got 43
points. I went up and had
a lady in travel mobile home
to show me how to string
beads.

In evening we played Bingo.

I won 2 cans of green
beans. and Charles 1 box of rice.
Had jelly and cup cakes for
refreshments.

Mar 4

Another nice day. Had not
do much in forenoon. In

afternoon called on the
Ray Lotts.

The Fred Murphys trailer
went out today and the
Le Favers have taken that
place. I watched Lawrence
Week's show and Charles
went to bed at 7:00.

Mar 5.

It rained early today was
raining at ten o'clock. We
got ready for church and
waited until it let up.
It started again on way to
Zephyrhills but let up again
when we got parked so did
not get very wet. It was
nice when we came out
of church. I invited the
Hallsbaums for dinner and
They were here waiting
when we got home from church.

They stayed until around 4:00
We had a nap and then
went for a little walk and
stopped at the Baco's.
Came home and watched TV.

Mar 6

Went down to shopping center
around 9:00 Charles had his
blood pressure taken in
mobile home next to coffee shop.

Mar 10

A cool morning but warmed
up in the sun but the wind
was cold. We went for little
walk then schuffled with

paul Haag and Eli woodard.
until lunch time. at Turkey
shoot we both got 15 points.
In evening at Bingo Charles
won a can of corn and
I didn't win anything.
They played regular Bingo,
make a X and make a T
also full your board.
Climber Wirthburg and Howard
Kurtz called the numbers.

Mar 11

Nothing exciting. a nice day
but a cool wind.
Several went to Disney World
from the park.
We shuffled a little in
forenoon Charles, Elmer Haag
Paul Haag and myself.
Got several letters today.

Mar 12

We went to church. saw

Aunt Opha and Uncle George,
just as we were getting to the
church. We sat together
Had dinner and nap. Took
a little walk and stopped
at Ernest Blenno. They
invited me stay for lunch.
In evening Uncle George's
came and brought us a little
meat and milk that they
had left over as they were
leaving for home Mon

Mar 13

Mrs Wallace and her son left
this morning around 7:30

I washed some things out by
hand. Went down town got
some rugs and crocheted cotton
to make doily. Stopped at
Thirteenthway for a few groceries.
Charles shuffled in afternoon.
Some people come in with

camper and parked beside
Parobecks garage. They were
from Jackson. He works in
Hardware store. They come to
meijers to shop.

Mar 14.

Did not do much in forenoon,
we went up and shuffled
a little in forenoon.

Afternoon I got 25 points
and Charles 32 in Turkey
shoot. Percy Woodrich won
the trophy and Helen Baker.
