of the other meals I am feeling quite a bit stronger  
yesterday & two day But we are so thankful that  
meat is taking care of and we feel we were  
fortunate that it kept cold till we got it done  
Dad did all the carrying thing down & up cellar  
in fact did most <sup>washed</sup> the cans and put meat  
in cans we were at it 3 day can. 439.1 pt  
and yesterday put the rest down for corn  
Beef I will cook the Bones for soup tomorrow.  
Dad has not felt any to good. Margie has been  
sick since wed. with La Grippe she had such  
a fever. Mrs. Grant called. Dr. Hollis Sugar he said  
she must not go to school and it was not possible  
for us to get her home and thought she was better  
then then to come out in cold. I called her  
yesterday and she thought she would be able  
to go back to school I have worried but hope  
she will be all right it seems its near rains

see it poor but I hope every one on the gain  
I am glad Mary Lou is gaining so nicely  
Eugene & Louisa I thank you both for  
offering to help take care of meat but you both  
have your hands full. I hope both families  
keep well. The Ground Hog did not see his  
shadow. Oh I must forgot to tell you we  
have our Electric lights turned the last day  
of January we are sure enjoying them I tell  
you it seems good to not have to carry lamp  
& lantern and hope they continue to work.

Louisa did you get your meat taken care of?  
we want to kill our Hogs as soon as I am  
able to care for it. Think I have been spazy  
nearly here enough. Those Grackles on  
the Acel. Dutton farm have a ~~half~~ Baby girl.  
you remember Mable counk the Gallop girl  
well. Her Boy is dead I think he was the oldest.  
I do not think of any more to write so will  
close. I thought if I wrote one letter would  
do for Both with lots of love
