Received your letter was glad to hear from you I have felt more like myself this afternoon than any time since I got sick I think when I get my strength back. I will be all right Dad. and Mr. Gresh have been cutting down some trees for a couple of days. yesterday afternoon Daddy went to Ellen Wassons funeral she died Sunday in Detroit with Bronchial Pneumonia it seemed very sad. Daddy said the church was full I did not try to go.

I swept Mr. Greshs room and. Daddy today and got the meals so that better than I have been doing.

Margie was home last week end and if the roads does not break up to much he is going after her to noon.

I did not say anything to her about what you said about her coming out there because I thought it was so cold and the roads not very good. she was better off not to come just now.

I saw by the Kossell paper that Daisy Roberts

was married at Toledo last Sat.

Dad packed Apples the other afternoon and  
I canned 4 qt 1 pt

We are wondering about Lonia Gilden  
we got a letter last Sat from her and she  
said Jean was getting along nicely I hope the

she does not have any pull back

Well Dad has got the chickens up to 8 Eggs.  
so that better I have not feed them only once  
last time right I guess that is the longest  
I have stayed away since that summer  
I was sick and you took care of them.

you and Dorothy could get acquainted I expect  
it will depend on the roads.
