

The last will & Testament of Daniel Goble of
Cortland in the County of Middlesex. this 20th. Sept. 1676.

I Commit my Soul to God who gave it, & my body to the dust from whom it was taken. And as for my Estate It is my declared will that Hannah my wife together with my brother Thomas Goble be joint executors. & that my Deceased wife fore-mentioned be in free & full possession of my House & howing Lands & effects for the comfort & maintenance of her & our several children during the time of her widow-hood, & in case shee changes her condition by marriage, or in state of her widow-hood be changed by death my will is that the estate be Reserved for & in time distributed conveniently amongst my four children that is Daniel & John, Hannah & Ellis Goble according to the direction of my brother Thomas Goble as also of John Birment. always to be understood that the thirds of this my last will, & Testamant. that is to say for my beloved wife during her natural life & then to returne to my children.
