it was taken. And as for my Estate It is my declared will that Hannah
my wife together with my brother Thomas Gobbe be joynt executors. & that
my deare wife be commended be in full & full possession of my House & Houf-
ing Lands & Estates for the comfort & maintenance of her & our fower
children During the time of her widdow-hood, & in case shee changed her con-
dition by marriage, or in state of her widdow-hood be changed by death my
will is that the estate be reserved for & in time distributed conveniently
amongst my fower children that is Daniel & John, Hannah & Ellis Gobbe
according to the direction of my brother Thomas Gobbe as attor of John Bed-
on & Jacob Moore whom I appoynt oversours of this my last will, & Testa-
ment. allways to be understood that the third of my estate be in case shee
marrye that tyeon is be for my beloved wife During her nital life & tyeon to
returne to my children.
