

JEHIEL LUM

He was born at New Milford, Ct.; was md. Apl. 13, 1788, to Mary Prindle of New Fairfield, Ct., now Sherman, by Ephraim Hubbell, J. P., in "North Society of New Fairfield." The record gives his name as "Hail." Mary Prindle was born Mch. 13, 1767, the dau. of Daniel and Jemima Prindle. Mary Prindle is said to have seen the Danbury, Ct., fire. Jehiel Lum moved to Franklin, Delaware Co., N. Y., and in the Federal Census of 1790 was in Albany Co., N. Y., and had in family two males over 16, two males under 16, and three females, including head of family. These could not all have been his children. He lived also at one time in Otsego Co., N. Y. He was bitten by a mad dog, and later in a fit of insanity wandered away and was never found. The children of Jehiel and Mary (Prindle) Lum were:

She md. Peter Myers, lived in Decatur, Otsego Co., N. Y., and went early to Mich. and died there, had four sons and one dau. One of the sons, Joseph, lived at Midland, Mich.
- III Urania, b. June 13, 1791.
md. John Estes, lived and died near Flint, Mich., and had descendants there.
- IV David, b. Aug. 10, 1792.
- V William, b. Dec. 21, 1795, d. aet. about 7 years.
- VI Samuel, b. Sept. 2, 1797.
md. 1st, Patience Luther, 2ndly, Mercy Mills, a widow with children. Samuel had none; lived at Castle Creek, Broome Co., N. Y.
- VII Reuben, b. Sept. 1, 1800, d. young.
- VIII Ransom Jehiel, b. Feb. 3, 1802.
- IX Helen Lasker, b. Oct. 26, 1804, d. July 26, 1872.
- X Minnie, md. Ephraim Bond; had children, Hiram, a builder, Hannah, Samuel and Marion; lived at Milwaukee, Wis.
