"son Joseph one acre of Land adjoining to his house lot, bounded north on the highway South on his Brother Ephraim's land and west on his Brother Jehoshaphat's land; also my Dwelling House and my house lot or Home lot,...excepting two acres at the West Side or end, and that my Son Jehoshaphat shall have the privilege of passing and repassing and laying wood on the west side of his dwelling house. sd Home Lot is bounded Northerly by the home Meadow, Easterly and southerly by common land or the highway. Provided he shall pay all my Debts and Legacies hereafter mentioned for which my movable estate is not sufficient. To my son Jonathan... To my son Nathan... To my son Ephraim, two acres of meadow land adjoining the North end of my home lot which two acres I bought of Edward Fairchild, To my son Jehoshaphat, my barn and two acres of Land being the westerly side or end of my Home lot and meadow, which two acres is bounded northerly on the home meadow, Westerly on Moses Stilson's land, Southerly on the highway and Easterly on that part of my home lot I above gave to my son Joseph. To the children of my son Benjamin Pringle Deceased twenty shillings to each of them when they come to the age of 26 years"
