Also I do give and bequeath unto my son John, the sum of Five shillings like Money. and also I do give and bequeath unto my daughter Susanna, the sum of Five shillings

like Money which respective sums of Money is to be
in full of each and every one of my ~~within~~^{& Expectancies} named
children their Shares ~~and~~ Portions out of all my ten-
ments of whatsoever nature the same may be, and which said
sums of Money are to be paid to my said children by my
Executors (herein after named) ^{within} one Year after my decease
if the same will be demanded by such child or chil-
dren.

And as touching all the Rest, Residue and Remainder
of my Estate, of what kind or nature soever the same may
be, or wheresover the same may be, I give devise and
bequeath the same unto my dear beloved wife Christina
to her own free voluntary use and behoof for ever.

And lastly, I do nominate, constitute and appoint
my said Wife Christina Executrix and my beloved Son
in-Law Jacob Hacklein of the Borough of Easton Executor
of this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all

and declaring this and no other, to be my last Will and
