

Cemetery at Plainfield.

The Cemetery at Planifield was taken from the Wyer property about 1838-39. The first death in that vicinty was that of a man named Welch from the State of n, y.

Plainfield postoffice. Mainfuld postoffice was established about 1837-38 with Emery Beal as poetmaster and was kept in the latter house. mail was brought from Melan (Unadella poetoffic) the route extending from ann arbor were Wester to unadella and return. Some mail was afterwards brought in from Mason Inghan Co. a tri weekly mail is now received from Fowlervelle to bradella. In 1853 when Morris Topping established himself in business he received the postmaster which is has since retained

The present hotel at the willage was built in 1876 by Morris Topping. The building is a frame structure and the first regular hetel.

1835-1837

In the meantime Flech Van Sackel bought land at plainfield but soon sold to Philip Wyn who became the second settler at the place. Where was also from New Jury and located here in 1836. He and Wunn both kept toverse. The place was originally know as Wyersbury but upon the establishment of a postoffice the name Plainfield was given.

When Fleet Van Sichel wold his place in place in place in place to Mr. Hyer he faid the money to his brother 5 amuel 7 Van Sichel who purchased land southeast of the village where his son Edger Van Sichel now lines, 5. 7. Van Sychel Came from New Jersey in company with Levi Clawson and after a short stay in Ohio proceeded to Nexter Washtman Co. finally docating en unadilla. One other of his some blavid lives near Edger southeast of Plainfield.

Morris Loffing moved to Plainfield 1839 with his father albert Is. Topping. The worked on his fathers form until 19 year old. The taught school three wenters, In 1853 he opened a store in plainfield. 1860 he added: to his business the manufacture of staves and barrels. 1867 he existed a sow mill and 1873 a great mill, stor years later both were distroyed by fire. There was no Ine The lost heavily. The soon replaced the mill, He also trected botel, blacksmith and wagen shop and is now building a large stone. He owns 3 of the village, He was postmoster 25 years Census 1874 - 535 males 531 females.

Log school house was built at plainfuld in 1837 on ground given by philip Wyer being the same lot on which the present frame school-house stands.
