But now Eugenia you remember before I came West you said, "you were not taking your full amount for fear it wouldn't last." With this much left have you claimed & recompensated yourself what is due? You should + no one but you + your books can tell that. You always pd. me the amount agreed upon + I believe you did Louisa + I hope you look out for Eugenia the same way. If you want me to write Louisa to this effect I will but I believe this one letter you can show her if you feel you want to and should be all that is necessary.

As to something of Mother's I don't know as there is anything Eugenia. From the division of Goods we made back in 48 or 49. I have several things and this western way of living + my physical condition seems like the less we have the better. When I get to thinking sometimes I wonder what will become of what I do have if I'm taken. Boys are different than girls + with no other relation here one just wonders?

As to the tatted pieces I hope you haven't sent them. I would rather if you don't want them give them to Barbara if she would like. I have several Pk of Pillow Cases + Scarves galore and no dress to

use them on. So I would much rather you would give anything I made there to some of the Grandchildren. They will think more of them than friends out here.

As to clothes I don't need any. Actually have more than need. I feel like a Hoarder sometimes. Hate to give away for think I may need but sure don't need more + someone is always bringing me something. So you see its not worth the postage. If the girls can't use to make over why not give to Church or Salvation Army or such. They are always in need of things.

I have thought at times about certain pictures but then its the same story. No one remembers or cares + as Niel said one time. Not for not caring but when you are gone this material has no meaning to me so it will have to be discarded. So its best we just drop the whole matter.

What did Louisa do with Mother's furniture that was upstairs at Adas? Not that I want just wondered who got. What was done with the Old Sheep Skin Bed to the farm? Would that be a relic for the Hist. Co. Historical Society. Do you suppose?

Ah yes I'm glad Dorwin was there + able to care for Mother + that they knew how to fix her hair that always make such an improvement. You remember Daddy looked much younger too. There really were quite a few went to General home. Who is Ted Bemar - Someone from Akemos? I've heard from Nora since but thats all other than you girls. We have several Drive In Banks here but they are connected to main bldg. a side drive along one side of bank. sure is an aid to quicker service. I guess Ha! I've never used it.

I'm in bed writing this. Been sneezing for a couple days last P.M. began to feel rather like a cold. This morn passage from head into throat are all raw. So I have to stay in bed now until thats gone to keep from poison building up + snapping back at me.

I miss Church today. We have a Mission Study on Sun. nites and its so good. I attended S. S. Hill Church now Geo. is at M. Y. J. + Hil will go up + theyll both stay to Mission Study. Frank will be home. He has some math. to do tonite for class tomorrow.

Tomorrow Commences a new + we expect his last semester.

Well I guess I've probably ~~scrambled~~ rambled on enough for now. Save some for another time. Must try to write Marjorie Davis - tonite. I wrote Lucille Rutter last wk.
