Dear Eugenia and all.

Received Mothers letter today.  
Was glad to get it and know you  
are improving. Thanks very much  
for money for battery. I shall see about  
it tomorrow Saturday. I am at Uncle  
Freds now. I just got through talking with  
Aunt Nina. U. Lynn is going to go get my  
battery and Clyde will put it in.

I have been faring quite well  
this week. I have my breakfasts at  
Uncle Freds and eat 3 pancakes and a egg  
or 2 pieces of meat which ever we have.  
Then yesterday we tied our quilt at Buttons  
and I got 2 meals there. Today Mrs  
Lillywhite invited me over for dinner  
we had fresh fish and ~~the~~ potatoes mashed,  
Buns, Tomatoes and after all that I ate  
a great big piece of Raspberry Pie.  
Imagine it. Is it any wonder I am gaining.  
I weighed 101  $\frac{3}{4}$  the next to the last time  
I was weighed mother. Tomorrow is missionary  
Dinner so I will have another good dinner.  
I had ought to get fat. Don't you think?  
Mrs Lillywhite said to tell you she

thought of you both often and hoped you (Eugene) would keep on gaining.

Oh yes! The farm is rented we closed the deal Monday afternoon. I do not know whether the Ferguson farm know it yet or not. Uncle Lynn is going to see them. Rosies seemed very pleased and seemed to want to do the right thing. He said that he would of course buy stock to feed and fat and when he did he would like to consult us on the matter so we would all be satisfied. And that is more than the others have done - as we know. Mr Stevenson passed away Tuesday morn. He had a stroke Monday and went right down. The funeral is tomorrow.

Saturday nite is the class party. I can hardly wait. We haven't had one in 5 miles as there are 5 Sundays in this month. We are planning some on a shadow social this next month. We will know more after Sat nite

I have rinsed, starched and ironed those 3 shirts of Daddys and I have them nearly all cut up into squares. I have figured out that his 6 shirts will make the quilt without putting anything else with them.

I have been hemming some sugar sacks for teacups towels today. Have 6 hemmed. Beside I have made a little tatting but not much. So you see I keep busy. My house doesn't get much attention only about 3 times a week. But of course I don't get it much dirty. I shall have to clean up tomorrow morn I guess before I go to church.

Mr Rose's were here at Uncle Freds Monday eve. Aunt Bertha had Popcorn and Sweet Cider for refreshments. We played Dominos until 11 o'clock and we sure had lots of fun. I haven't seen Mrs Donohue since Sat. It sure seems ages. Hope to see her soon, perhaps tomorrow or next day.

Can't think of anymore news so will close for now.
