I am off duty for $1\frac{1}{2}$ hr. now. At present I am lying on bed twisting so as to rest my feet & back. When I'm on duty I'm on my feet all the time.

We get up at 6:10 or 15 go to breakfast at 6:30, Work at 7:00 off depending on when we get through, all the way from 10 to 10:45 Eat at 11:30 On duty at 12:00 off when work is done. Usually from 2:25 to 3:00 then we are off until 4:30 When we go to supper On duty at 5:00 off at 7:15 to 8:00.

We are having Ice Cream for dinner today.
Tomorrow we have Fish.

I went downtown yesterday P. M. and didn't get ~~my~~ any rest until night. I went to bed about 9:00.

How are you getting along?

for any money. if not
you had better send me about
\$4.00 and I will divide with
her. As you know I have
had to buy a few extra
things to come up here.
As yet I've only bought one
uniform. I'm wearing my
house dresses and things.
As I'm on just temporary.
Hope to get on permanently.
I shall have to wash tomorrow.

I suppose it has
been quite cold out. I've
only been out ^{side} once since
I came. But some of the
rooms up in the
Wings are terribly cold.
However mine isn't
bad.
