The Progenitor of the WILKERSON families
of southern Brown County, Indiana

The above dates and age at death are from a letter written in 1933
by a granddaughter, Jane Wilkerson Beightel to the U.S. Pension
Department. She stated that William died on a little farm that he
owned on Crooked Creek in Brown County, that before he died he went out
on his farm and located the place where he wanted to be buried. When
he died he was buried on the spot he had chosen, the first person to
be buried there. At the time she wrote the letter she commented that
"a right smart-sized" cemetery was there then. She also said she had
found the dates of his birth and death on the tombstone as given above.
She further stated that his wife died July 6, 1846.

Other records confirm that he died in the summer of 1842, but the exact
dates differ. The History of Greene Co., Indiana, published by Blanchard
and compiled by Weston Goodspeed, 1884, states that William Wilkerson
was born Jan. 5, 1736 and died in the summer of 1842, age 106 years,
6 months, 1 day. This would put his date of death at July 6, 1842.

The Circuit Court Order Book B, page 390, Brown Co., Ind., in the matter of William Wilkerson, states that he died in Brown County on July 12, 1842, that he was a revolutionary war pensioner at the rate of \$20 per annum. This date was evidently supplied by his children and does not agree with other dates given.

On July 19, 1986 William's gravestone was found in the Fleetwood Cemetery, buried under layers of leaves, by Kris Delano Hardy, a great-great-great-grandson. Although most of the inscription on the crude sandstone marker is flaked off and illegible, the name Wilkerson and the birth date - Jan. 1735 can be read.

Most of what is now known about William Wilkerson comes from Revolutionary war pension records found under File No. S. 32602, as follows:

He was born in King George Co., Virginia, date not given. He stated that he was a small boy at the time of Braddock's Defeat (but this took place on July 9, 1755). His father, whose name is not given, moved to Granville Co., North Carolina. William, while residing in Granville Co., enlisted and served as a private with the North Carolina troops - from May 1776 or 1777, three months in Captain John Henderson's company, Colonel R. Harris' regiment; in same year three months in Captain Joseph Gill's company; in 1779, three months in Captain Micajah Bullock's company; again in 1779, three months in Captain Jones Fuller's company; in 1781, two months, names of officers not given.

About ten or fifteen years after the Revolution, William Wilkerson moved from Granville County to the great fishery at the Narrows of the Yadkin River in Rowan County, North Carolina. From there to Knox County, Ky. and thence to Monroe County, Ind., where he was living in 1835. His pension application was executed there March 4, 1835 when he gave his age as about 94 years. His application indicates he was unsure as to

when he was born. He stated that he first married when he was about twenty years of age. He did not name his wives nor dates and places of his marriages. He had twenty-one children - fifteen sons and six daughters.

By 1840 William was living in Johnson Township, Brown Co., Ind. where he was enumerated in the federal census of that year. He was listed in the "over 100 years of age" column and on a following page it gives his age as 101 years. The only female in the household is in the 40 to 50 year old column. If this is his wife (Jemima?) she is less than half his age.

Of the twenty-one children mentioned in the pension papers we have names and information only on the ones who also settled in the Brown County, Ind. area and who appear in public records there, or are named in correspondence of granddaughter Jane Beightel.

OTHER SETTLERS.

In 1833, Solomon Wilkerson, a native of North Carolina, was married to Miss Polly Anderson, a native of Kentucky. In 1835, he erected and moved into a house near where the stable he built now stands. This was the first house erected near where Solsberry now stands. His father, William Wilkerson, born January 5, 1786, was a soldier in the American Revolution. He lived one year in one apartment of his son's house. He died in Brown County, Ind., in the summer of 1842, at the advanced age of one hundred and six years, six months and one day. The day he was one hundred years old he split one hundred rails on the hill now occupied by the dwelling built by Dr. Axtell. He delighted to tell of his patriotism during the Revolutionary struggle, and in his extreme old age would sing for the amusement of his friends the familiar hymn, "I would not live alway, I ask not to stay."

SOLOMON WILKERSON'S VILLAGE.

In 1856, a village was laid out by Solomon Wilkerson, and named in honor of himself. He was a Justice of the Peace for several years, and was held in high esteem by his neighbors. Several years ago, his life was brought to an abrupt termination, he being thrown from a horse near the Bateman Ford, on Richland Creek. He had not quite reached his hundredth year.

Solomon Wilkerson laid out the village of Salsberry in 1856 and it was named in his honor. He was a Justice of the Peace there. In 1835 he built a house near where Salsberry now stands, the first house erected there. Solomon's life was brought to an abrupt end, he being thrown from a horse near the Bateman Ford on Richland Creek. (Information from History of Greene and Sullivan Counties, State of Indiana, Chicago, Goodspeed, 1884, pgs. 264-265 and 268.) This biographical sketch also states Solomon had not quite reached his hundredth year at time of death. This does not check with dates we read on his old marble gravestone which is badly eroded.

Solomon's wife Mary (or Polly as she is named in marriage record and censuses of 1850 and 1860) survived her husband, it would appear.

Although she is omitted from 1870 Census, in the 1880 census she is shown as Mary Wilkerson, mother, age 62, b. Tenn. in home of Frank Wilkerson at Salsberry.

State of Indiana

Monroe County:

On this the fourth day of March in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty five personally appeared before me the individual signed Stephen T. Seal, one of the Associate Judges of the Circuit Court of said County of Monroe in said state said Court being a court of record composed of a President and two associate judges, William Wilkerson aged about 90 years of age resident in said County of Monroe and said state of Indiana who being first duly sworn according to law doth on his Oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the benefit of the Act of Congress passed June 7th, 1832. That he entered the service of the United States under the following named officers and served as hereinafter stated to wit.

He was born in King George County, Virginia. He never could read or write. His father had a record of his age, which at his death may have been disposed of among the other children or lost before that time, at any rate he has no knowledge of it now. From the information acquired from his father and as well as he has been able to keep it in his memory his best impression was and is that he is now about ninety four years old. He may be a few years younger or some older.

He states that by reason of his (great) old age and especially sickness (having been attacked about the first of August last and not recovered) and the consequent loss or failure of memory he cannot swear positively as to the dates or the several tours hereinafter mentioned nor can he enumerate many circumstances all of which he could before his sickness have stated with some degree of accuracy but he recollects clearly and swears positively that he served not less than (but) the periods mentioned (hereinafter) below and in the following grades.

He recollects Braddocks defeat he was at the time a small boy. He recollects well the Regulation Battle which was fought I think on or near Little Alimana River in Randolph, Guilford, Orange or adjoining County in North Carolina his father having removed to Granville County in said state of North Carolina when he applicant (paper creased here)---

(paper folded here)--- impression---- by and about the time of the Regulation Battle he was at that time twenty years of age at least and probably older. He was but a short time after this battle, married to his first wife. He recollects some of the circumstances as they are related at the time of the Battle and about that time. He thinks that Colonel Branson, General Sassons (not perhaps then a General) Morrill ????????? Butler and were some what distinguished either in the Battle or the bringing of it about. He thinks Colonel Harris was there.

The Regulators commenced the Battle by firing upon some of the men of Colonel Harris while some attempts were making to enquire into the intentions or purposes of the regulators. Old Doctor or Colonel Tyler who was in the Tory band or perhaps their leader at the time. They were surprised or rather mistook Colonel Lee and Whig troops for British at the Race Paths in Guilford or Randolph or thereabout, this applicant has the impression was there from report at the time as also Governor Tryson.

He resided in said County of Granville, North Carolina until entering the service for the first tour following
 (1st) He entered the service of the United States as a Volunteer private soldier in the Militia of the State of North Carolina in the company commanded by Captain John Henderson in the Regiment commanded by Colonel R. Harris. Some time during this tour the troops in which he served were as strong and sometimes much less than a full regiment. They were marched in small bands to, and rendezvoed at Randolph Court House. Then marched to Caswell Court House. Thence about Tar River thence about Hillsborough in Orange County, North Carolina. We crossed Flat River, Little River, ?????????????? and Little River of Pedee. He cannot

60 defeated the Scots and killed their Colonel McCloud. It was the month of May and his best impression is that

63 (2nd) He entered said service again for a second tour as a private in the Militia of North Carolina in the Company of

85 (4th) He again for a fourth tour entered the service in the Militia of the State of North Carolina as a volunteer private
86 soldier in a company of Infantry under Captain John Fuller to serve three months. They, said Company and
87 this applicant, met at Oxford in Granville County, North Carolina, he then residing in said county and
88 marched for Neuse River at a point near the fork of Flat River and Little River, then they were marched to a
89 place where the Tories were said to be imbodyed: They had disappeared before we arrived there. We were then
90 marched in several directions and to different places in quest of the Tories to points where our Officers

96 putting tickets into a hat balloted or drew lots for the tour. This applicant having drawn a ticket to serve hired a
97 man by the name of Weaver as a substitute, and gave him sixty dollars to serve three months being the time
98 they were called on to serve. His said substitute served out the three months to the acceptance of his officers as

he was informed and believes. Afterwards being called out in the same manner of a tour of nine months he

as a substitute to serve said nine months which he performed to the acceptance of his officers as he was informed. After which being again called out in the same manner he served in the service until after the Battle of Guilford. He was called out for three months but there being nothing further to do after said Battle he was dismissed before the expiration of the three months. He served at least two months. He can not state what year the Battle of Guilford took place in. He had served two months or near it at the time of said Battle and continued in the Army a short time after made this tour said two months. At the present moment he is unable to recall the name of the Captain of the Company in which he served said last tow months. However deficient in recollecting the names of some of his Officers and many circumstances he is clear and swears positively that he served not less than the periods stated to wit.

In answer to the interrogations prescribed by the War Department he makes the following answers.

As to the 1st interrogatory: He cannot say what year he was born in but believes he is about ninety four years old as before stated in the body of his Declaration.

As to the 2nd: He has already stated that he neither has any record of his age nor does he know where it is.

As to the 3rd interrogatory: He was living in Granville County, North Carolina when entering the service in all his said tours. At the end of the War I was still living in said county. I resided there about ten or fifteen years after the war ended. Then moved to the great fishery at the Narrows of the Yadkins in Rowan County in said state and lived there near twenty years, then I removed to Kentucky into Knox County where I lived eighteen or twenty years and then I removed to Monroe County, Indiana where I now live and have for four years and upwards. Upon reflection he thinks he did not live quite as long at said Fishery as stated above.

As to the 4th: He volunteered in his said forces for two tours, hired substitutes in the next two and drew lots in the last two as before stated.

As to the 5th: Colonel Taylor of the Militia perhaps he might not have been in service I saw him every court and was well acquainted with him. Colonel (Judge) Williams cannot say whether a regular or Militia Officer. Colonel White Militia Officer might not have been in service. Colonel Burton. Colonel Henderson.

As to the 6th: He never received nor applied for a discharge.

As to the 7th: Christopher Cox, William Johnston, Joseph Johnston Revolutionary soldiers and pensioners, Joseph Parks, Old Mr. William Hensly, Jacob Romans, Samuel Smith. Daniel Johnston Revolutionary Pensioners Moses

167 He entered the Service and served as a private in all of said tours. He will he has no doubt upon giving himself
168 longer time, and reflecting recollect the name of his Captain in said two months service in which as stated herein.
169 The object of his expedition was to reinforce the "head General" in the south, and in a great battle which was then
170 expected would be fought some where in that part of the country. They were destined at the same time that they

178 He has been twice married and had twenty-one children; fifteen sons and six daughters. That being entitled to a
179 pension under the old laws he never applied. He has followed the range (or stock raising in back settlements ever
180 since a few years after the close of the Revolution with the exception of the time he lived at the great fishery on the
181 Yadkin. His father gave him land. He had two good farms in said County of Granville, N.C. and having spent more
182 than a thousand good dollars in the War, lost crops and had other losses, he moved into the ranges in Granville out
183 some distance from the neighborhood of his father he had resided, then to the Fishery and again and since into the
184 ranges. Living in the range in Knox and in the extreme part of this county among the Hills of Salt Creek he never
185 knew that he could probably get a pension under the present act until about a year ago. He then went to Louisville to
186 see a brother who he was informed resided there, by whom he expected to prove his services, not then knowing but
187 that positive proof was necessary in his case. When he got to Louisville he was told that a very old man of the name
188 had some time previously died there, he never got off his horse but turned and came home He knows of no person
189 now by whom he can prove a personal knowledge of his services.

190 The person (J.Q. Lowe) now making out his declaration as his son informed him promised to visit his house by
191 summer for this purpose, but did not, and this applicant being taken sick soon after his return from Louisville he
192 thinks in consequence of his fatiguing journey has not been able to attend to the business until lately. He never
193 received any pay for any of his services. He has no documentary evidence that he knows of and knows of no person
194 whom evidence of a personal knowledge of his services he can procure. He hereby relinquishes every claim
195 whatever to a pension except the present and declares that his name is not on the pension rolls of he Agency of any
196 State.
