

C. H. Boomer, Former Co Supervisor, Dies; Rites M



Clement H. Boomer, 83, of 1294 W. Bristol Rd., a lifelong resident of Flint Township and former member of the Board of Supervisors, died Friday at the Kith Haven Convalescent Home.

Services will be at 1:30 P. M. Monday at the Algoe-Gundry Mortuary with the Rev. Edward H. Wilcox officiating. Burial will be at Bristol.

Mr. Boomer was born in Flint Township May 24, 1867, son of Ben and Unity Boomer. His father and mother both came to the Flint area as small children. He was born on his father's farm in Flint township, where he lived until he married Isabelle F. Henry on April 17, 1895, and they moved to the farm where he spent his life. She was a teacher in the area for a time. He was an extensive sheep raiser.

Mr. Boomer served as a member of the Carman School Board for 25 years, was treasurer of Flint Township and represented the township on the Board of Supervisors for 7 years in the 1920's.
