Albert Chapman, First Mal? Child Born in Chesaning, Died in Montana.

Mrs. J. Eliza Waldron has received a letter announcing the death of her half-brother, Albert Wellington Chapman, death having occurred August 14, 1914, in Superior, Montana, after a short illness caused by paralysis, having suffered three strokes in one day.

Deceased was of especial interest in Chesaning history, having been the first male white child born in this village. He was born on the Chapman farm August 28, 1842, and resided here until about 20 years ago.

He is survived by a daughter, Mrs. Anna Pettit, of Flint, and a son, Guy, who resided with his father.
