George H. Chapman, 89, died Friday, March 24, at 5:40 a.m. at Clinton Memorial Hospital in St. Johns following a long illness.

Funeral services were held at Osgood Funeral Home in St. Johns on Monday at 1 p.m. with the remains being brought to Wildwood Cemetery for burial.

He was born April 6, 1871, the son of Wm. H., and grandson of George W. Chapman, one of the first settlers in Chesaning. He graduated from Chesaning High School in 1888 and went into the dry goods business. He bought the St. Johns Portable Building Co. in 1906 and sold it in 1935. On Aug. 20, 1935, he married Irene Taylor of East Lansing.

He leaves his wife; one son, Donald H. of Long Island, N. Y.; one daughter, Dorothy of Tulsa, Okla.; two half-sisters, Mrs. Alice Cook of Detroit, and Mrs. Mable Munger of Connorsville, Ind. One son, George died about one year ago.
