Death of Henry Cooper

Death of Henry Cooper -- One of the best known men in this section was **Henry W. Cooper**, who was born in Linden, March 8, 1860, and had been a life long resident of the vicinity. July 4, 1888, he was united in marriage with Huldah Emily White, to whom eight children were born, three of whom are deceased, Baby Henry Jr., Samantha E. Selden, and Ida Belle. The surviving members left to mourn beside his faithful companion, are Varrie E. Morey of Linden, William B., Nathan I., and Julia L. Hart of Detroit, and Viola M. Cooper of Flint; also seven grandchildren, two brothers, A. J. and Samuel Cooper of Detroit, and his only uncle, Mills Cooper of Coloma, and a host of friends who will greatly miss him. After three weeks serious illness, he was taken to Hurley Hospital to undergo an operation for appendicitis, from which he failed to recover and passed to the home beyond Wednesday, August 28, 1929, leaving a triumphant testimony that he had passed from death unto life. Funeral services were held at the Free Methodist Church Friday afternoon conducted by the Pastor, Rev. Whims. Burial was at Fairview Cemetery, Linden.
