

MRS. ALBERT GREGG DIES IN HER WESTERN HOME

Word came to George Delamarter of this city late last week of the death of his sister, Mrs. Albert Gregg, which occurred at her home at San Bernadino, California, on Thursday, November 16th after three severe strokes.

The remains were then taken to their old home at Bozeman, Mont., and there laid at rest in the Masonic cemetery beside those of her husband who had preceded her for some time to the life beyond.
