

Baby Born After Mother Dies At U. Of M. Hospital

ANN ARBOR (AP)—A premature baby was born at University Hospital here five minutes after the mother died of leukemia, hospital officials reported today.

Mrs. Stanley Knopf, 27-year-old wife of a Mason farmer, learned she was afflicted with the fatal blood disease only 10 days ago, her husband said. She entered the hospital last Friday and died at 10 a. m. Thursday.

Doctors delivered the baby, a girl, by caesarian section five minutes later. She weighed 3 pounds and 7 ounces.

Attendants reported the infant in "good condition." She was born two months prematurely.

Mrs. Knopf leaves two other daughters, Barbara, 4, and Brenda, 1½.
