

MRS. H. HAYDEN ^R IS LAID TO REST

Resident Of Community All Her Life; Funeral Services Held Monday Afternoon

Mrs. Abbie Hayden, 69, wife of Frank Hayden and a resident of this community all of her life, died at 7:30 a.m. May 9, at her home a mile and one-half northeast of here. She had been in poor health for some time. Immediate cause of death was a slight cerebral hemorrhage and a stroke. 1942.
