

# Fall Fatal To Woman

Elderly Resident of  
Garyton Succumbs  
At Hospital Here

Mrs. Amella L. Anderson, wife of Edward A. Anderson, of Garyton, became the second elderly woman to die following a home fall last week.

The 71-year-old north Porter county resident succumbed Sunday at Porter Memorial hospital, where she was taken after her right leg was fractured between the knee and hip following a tumble at her home Wednesday afternoon. Earlier in the week Mrs. Ida Mae Williams, 68, was found dead after a fall down a flight of stairs at the home of a daughter in Beatrice, where she had been residing.

A life-long resident of Porter, Mrs. Anderson was born Jan. 18, 1879, and was united in marriage in McCool Nov. 25, 1903, to Edward A. Anderson. She is well known here.

Surviving in addition to the husband and a son, Evert of Hobart; two daughters, Mrs. Eleanor Marshall of Valparaiso and Mrs. Helen Cruikshank of Gary; five grandchildren; and two brothers, James and Harvey Lunburg, both of Gary.

Memorial services will be held Wednesday, Aug. 9, at 2 p. m. at the First Methodist church, Hobart, with the Rev. H. L. Adams officiating. Burial will be in McCool cemetery. The Pflughoeft funeral home, Hobart, is in charge of arrangements.
