

CRUSHED BY LOG

NATHAN SELDEN OF MUNDY
TOWNSHIP MET DEATH
YESTERDAY.

READY TO START FOR FLINT

Log Rolled off Wagon And Crushed
His Life Out Almost Instant-
eously.

Linden, Jan. 9.—A deplorable accident occurred yesterday on a farm four miles north of this village in Mundy township, resulting in the instant death of Nathan Selden, aged twenty years.

Young Selden was engaged loading logs to haul to Flint when a hook on one of the chains that held the load on the wagon broke, and one of the logs rolled off, striking Selden, knocking him down and crushing his life out.

Selden was one of the most popular young men of the township of Mundy, and his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Frank Selden are among the most prominent people in the township. He had been living with his grandmother, Mrs. Chauncey Bagley, and worked her farm in Mundy township, where the accident occurred. The deceased is survived by his parents, two brothers and four sisters. The funeral will be held tomorrow afternoon at 1 o'clock from the M. E. church at South Mundy, Rev. E. G. C. Benson of the Linden M. E. church officiating.
