Melvin S. Wallace, age 56, of Hastings, Minn. died suddenly Saturday, June 27, 1998, while visiting family in the Denver, Colo. area. Melvin, the son of Robert Bruce Wallace and Claire Beth (Delamarter) Wallace, was born on March 3, 1942 in Saginaw, Mich. After graduating from Arthur Hill High School in 1960, he served four years in the U.S. Navy and was honorably discharged in 1965.
