

G. W. WARD DEAD R

George W. Ward, for many years a well-known and respected resident of Chesaning, but whose home for some years past has been in Denver, Colo., died in that city, on Jan. 14, last, of miner's consumption, contracted through many years of work in the mines. He was born in New England, Ohio, in 1857, the eldest of five sons of Warren S. and Sarah G. Ward, coming with his parents to Chesaning, in 1858. Besides a widow, Mr. Ward is survived by four brothers, Wellington and Fred, of Owosso, Louie, of Midland, and Frank, of Lansing. Mr. Ward was a cousin of G. L., James and O. D. Chapman, and of Mrs. J. E. Waldron. The remains were interred at Denver.
