

Death of Warren S. Ward R

Warren S. Ward was born in Belchertown, Mass., Nov. 18, 1824, and died March 18, 1904. Was married to Sarah G. Chapman of Belchertown, Nov. 16, 1848, who died in January, 1902. Mr. Ward was connected with railroad building through Massachusetts, Connecticut, New York City and Ohio. In the spring of 1856 he came from Ohio to Chesaning and bought his farm southeast of town, returning to Ohio and brought his family in 1857, returning to Ohio in 1858, then back to Chesaning in 1861, where he spent the rest of his days until

last November when he went to Owosso to live with his son Fred, where he died. There were seven children, two daughters and five sons, of whom the five sons survive him. George W., of Black Hawk, Col.; A. Wellington, of Owosso, Lewis E., of Ingersoll; Fred G., of Owosso and Frank E., of Chesaning. There are eighteen grand children and one great grand son, Walter Drake, of Charlotte. also one brother in Massachusetts. The funeral was held Monday afternoon from the house at 2 o'clock Rev. J. W. Campbell officiating and interment was made at Wildwood.
